Weather Update Dated 31-08-2025

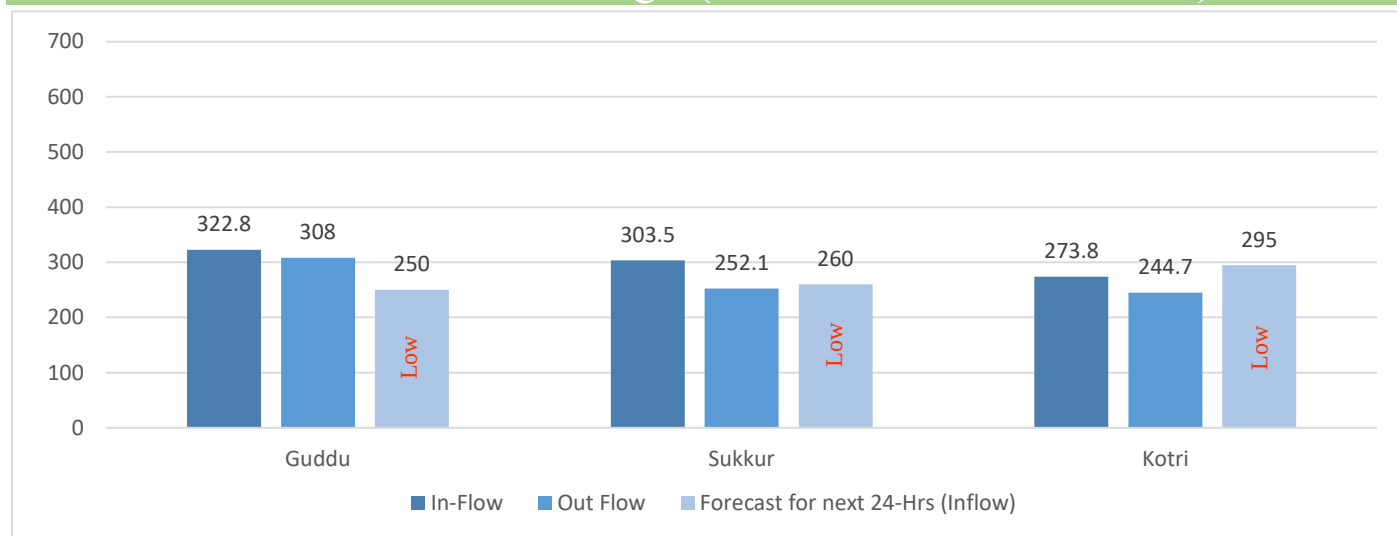
Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that:

- Hot and humid weather likely in most parts of the province.
- Thunderstorm/ Rain** is expected at few places in Jacobabad, Kashmore, Ghotki, Khairpur, Kamber Shahdadkot, Sanghar, Umerkot, Thatta, and Tharparkar districts today.
- Guddu, Sukkur, and Kotri Barrages are witnessing **Low**-level flood.

Note: River Indus at Guddu and Sukkur is expected to attain **very high flood on 4th to 5th September.**

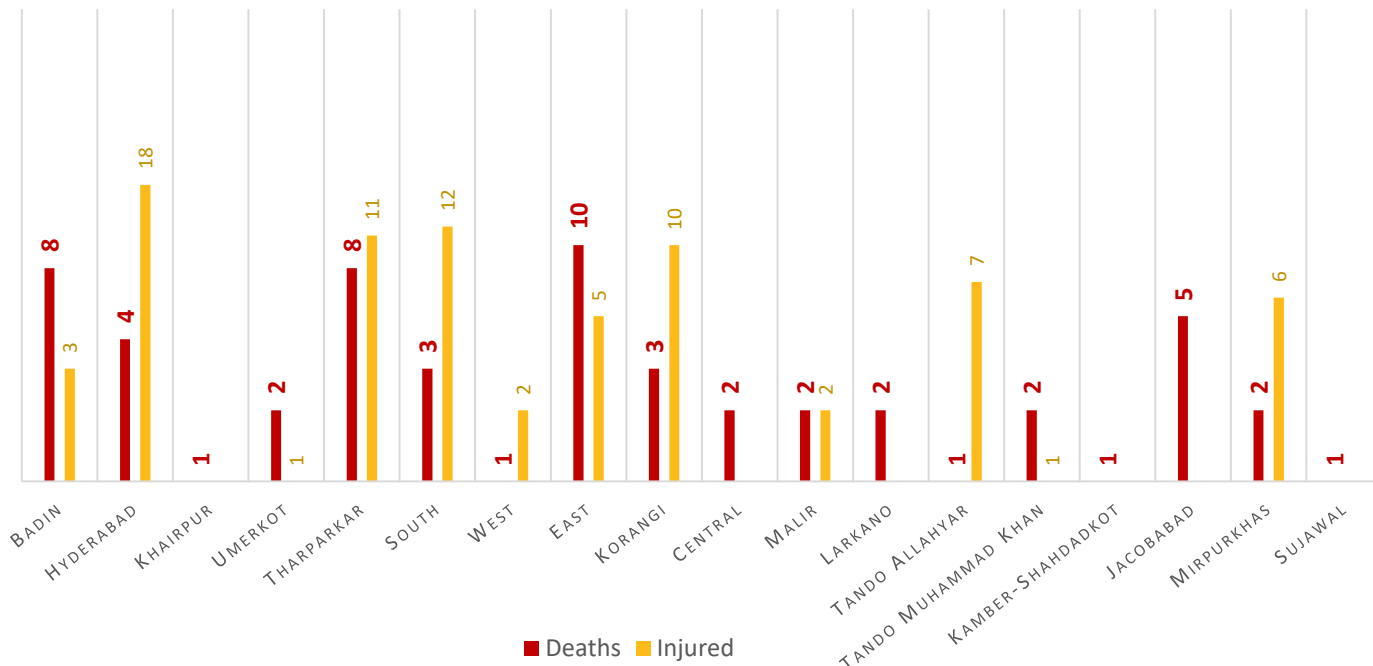

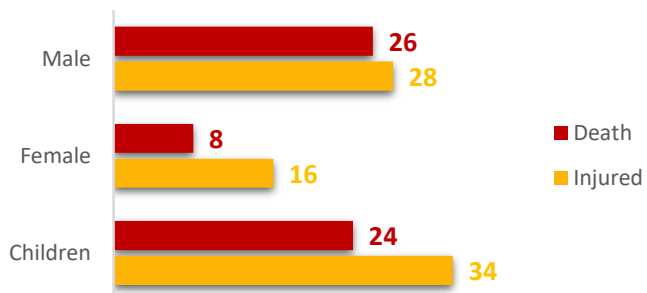


Cumulative Casualties – Deaths / Injuries (25-06-2025 to 01-09-2025)

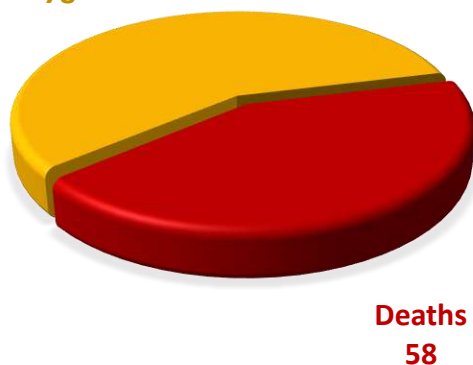
DISTRICT-WISE DEATHS & INJURIES



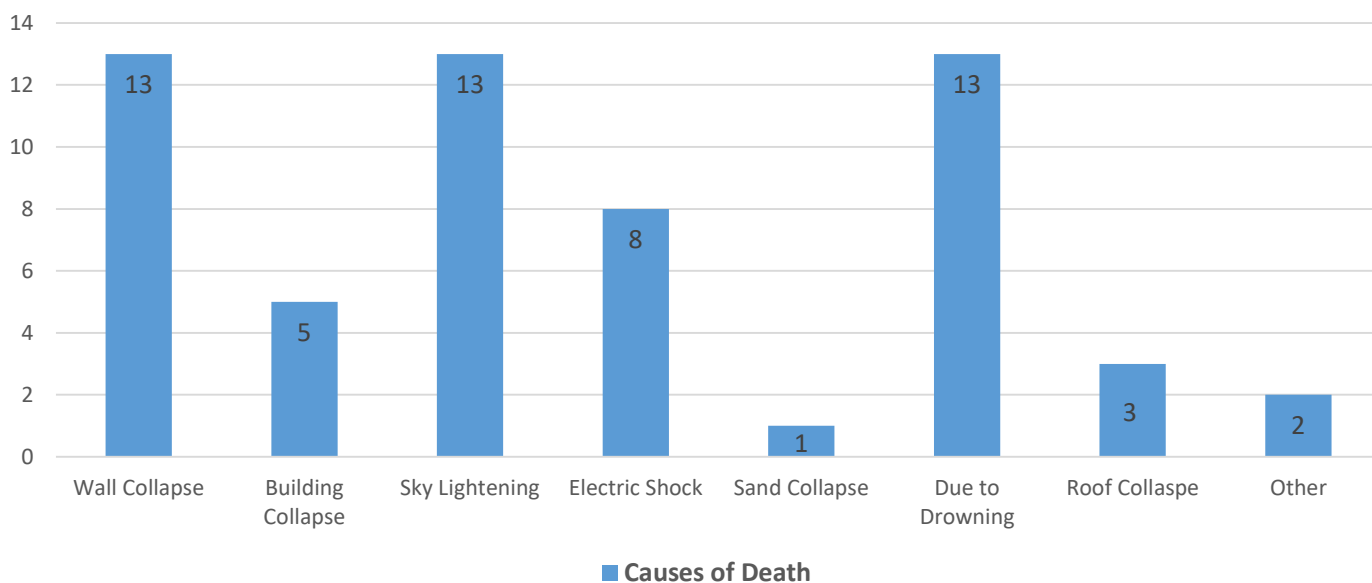
GENDER-WISE DISTRIBUTION

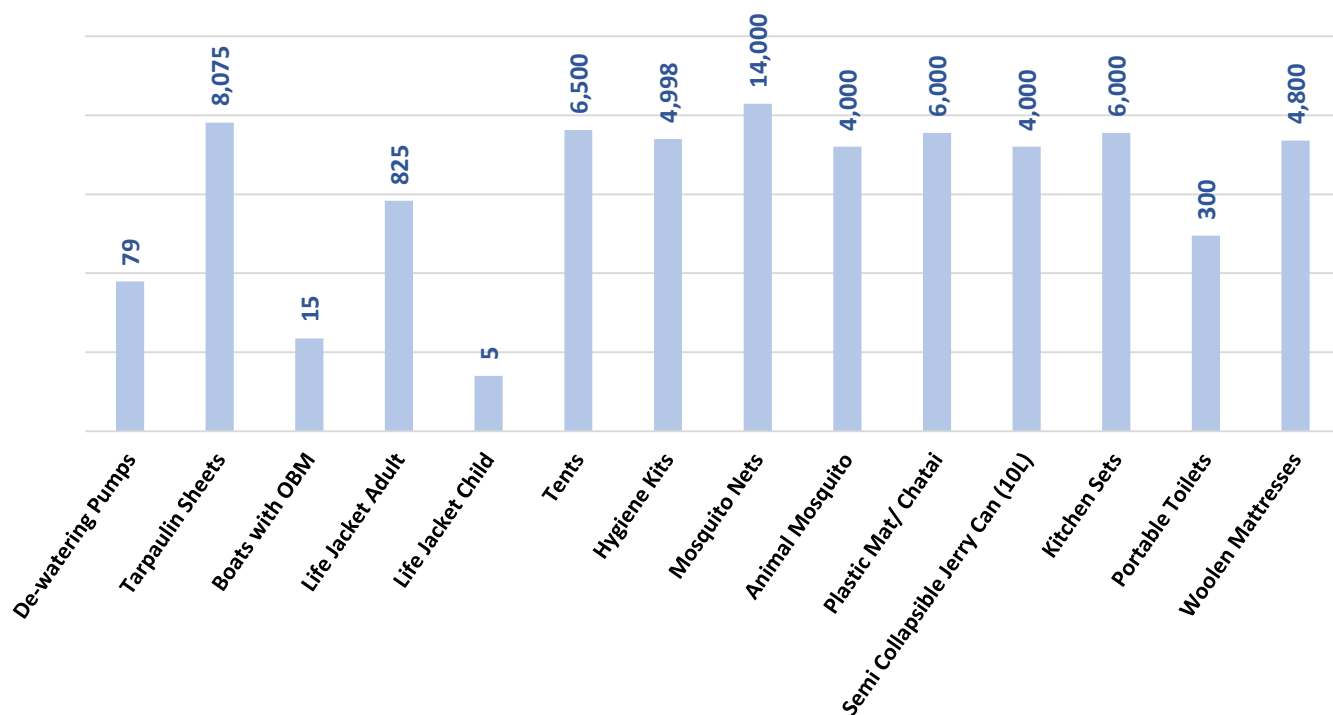
