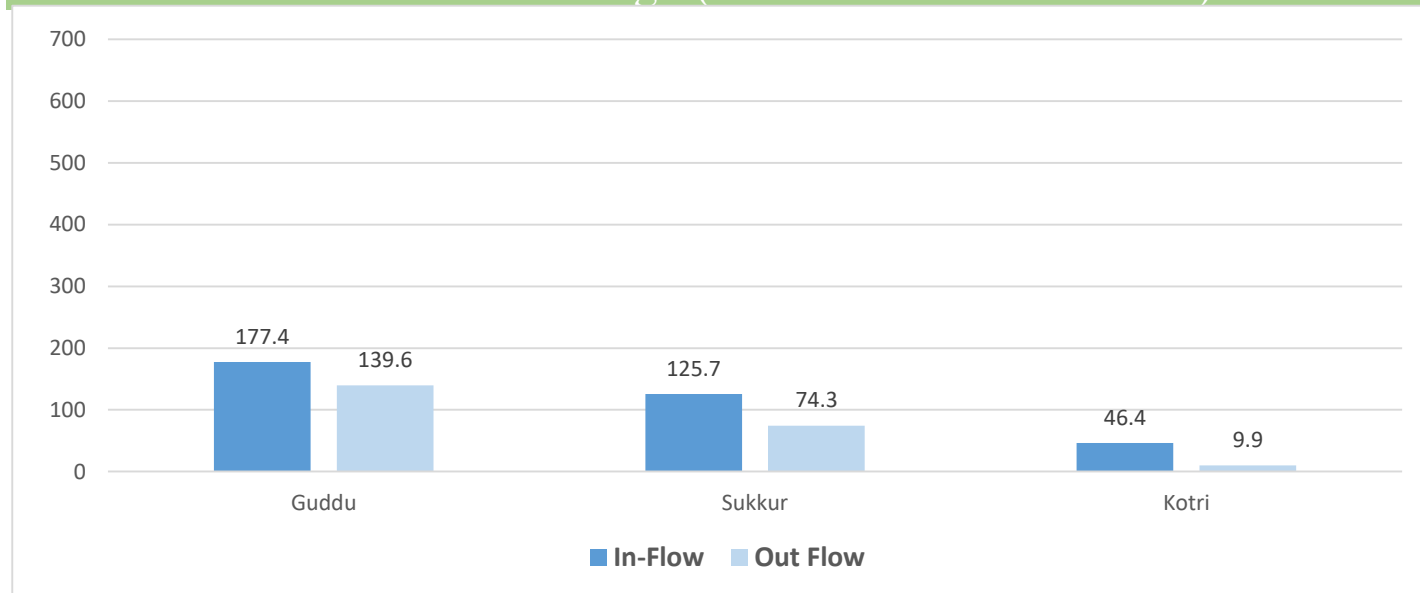
Weather Update Dated 09-07-2025

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that weak monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in the southeastern parts of the province.

- Isolated light rain/Drizzle likely in Qambar Shahdaskot, Larkana, Dadu, Jamshoro, Thatta, Sujawal, Badin, Tharparker, Umerkot districts and Karachi division today.
- However Partly cloudy, hot and humid conditions are likely to prevail in the rest of the province.

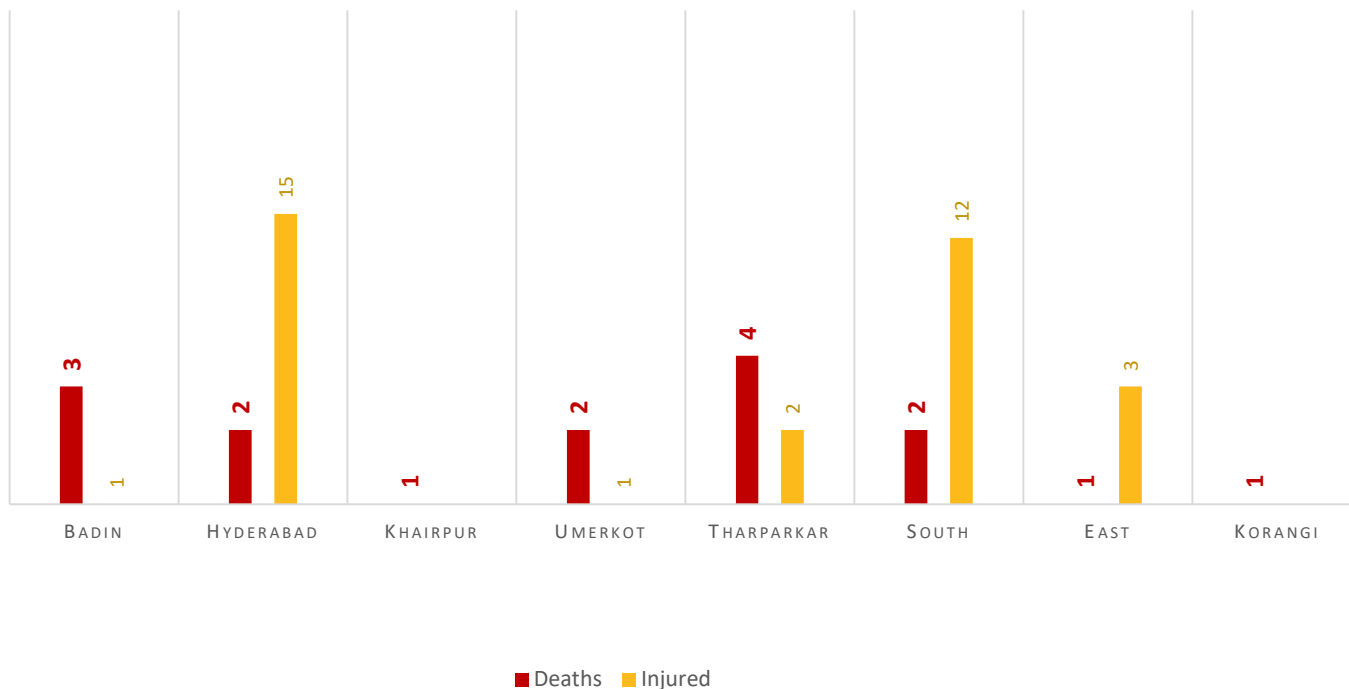

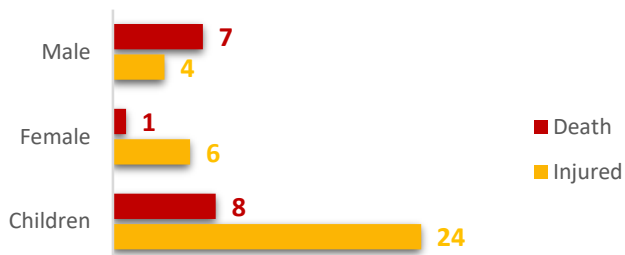


Cumulative Causalities – Deaths / Injuries (25-06-2025 to 09-07-2025)

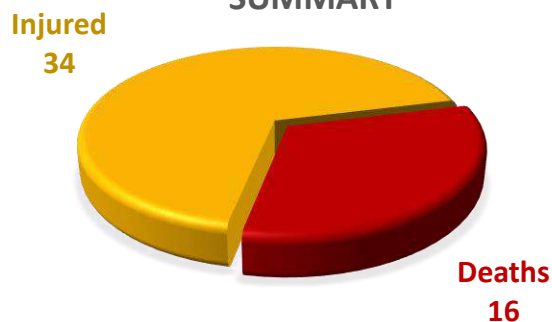
DISTRICT-WISE DEATHS & INJURIES



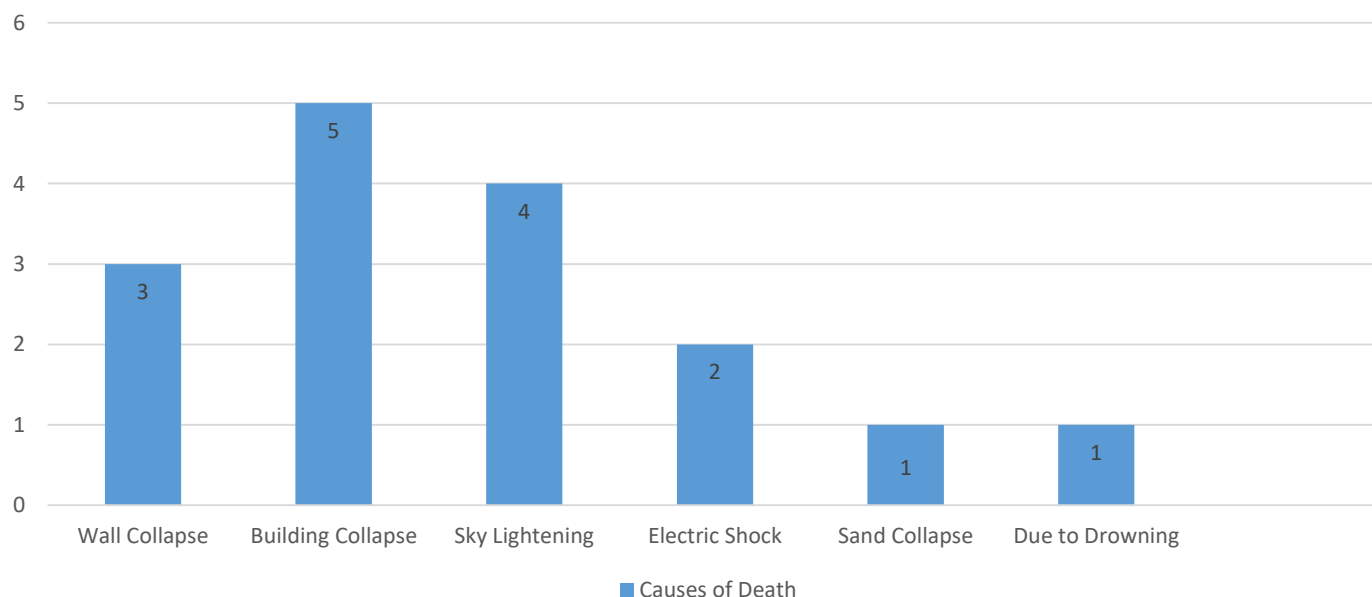
GENDER-WISE DISTRIBUTION

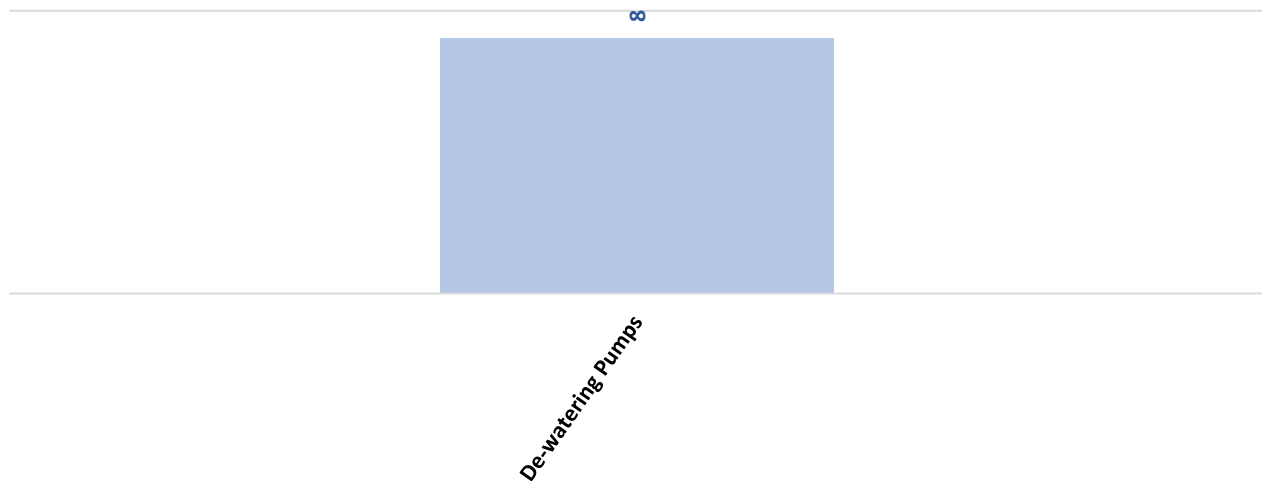
