

Weather Update Dated 2

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that Strong Monsoon currents from Arabian Sea & Bay of Bengal are likely to penetrate upper parts of the country from 22nd August. Under its influence:

- Rain-wind/ thundershower is expected in Mithi, Tharparkar, Umerkot and Mirpurkhas from 23rd (evening/night) to 26th August with occasional gaps.
- Heavy rains are expected in Sindh from 27th to 29th August.





- The Deputy Commissioner Tando Allahyar has reported that 5 Male & 2 Female were injured due to roof collapse on 19-08-2025






