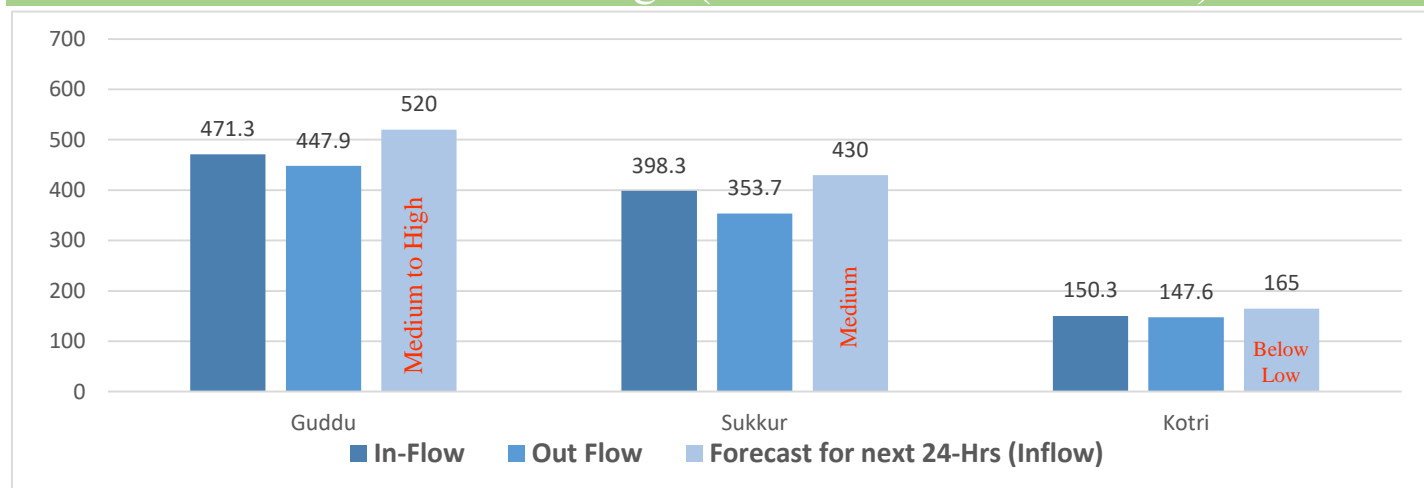
Weather Update Dated 22-08-2025

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that Monsoon currents are continuously penetrating into most parts of the province. Under its influence:

- Rain / Thunderstorm likely in Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Umerkot, Thatta, Sujawal, Badin, Matiari, Tharparkar, Mirpurkhas, and Sanghar districts today.
- Light rain / drizzle may occur in Karachi division today.
- Guddu Barrage experiencing Medium-level flood, Sukkur Barrage a low-level flood and Kotri Barrages witnessing normal water flow.

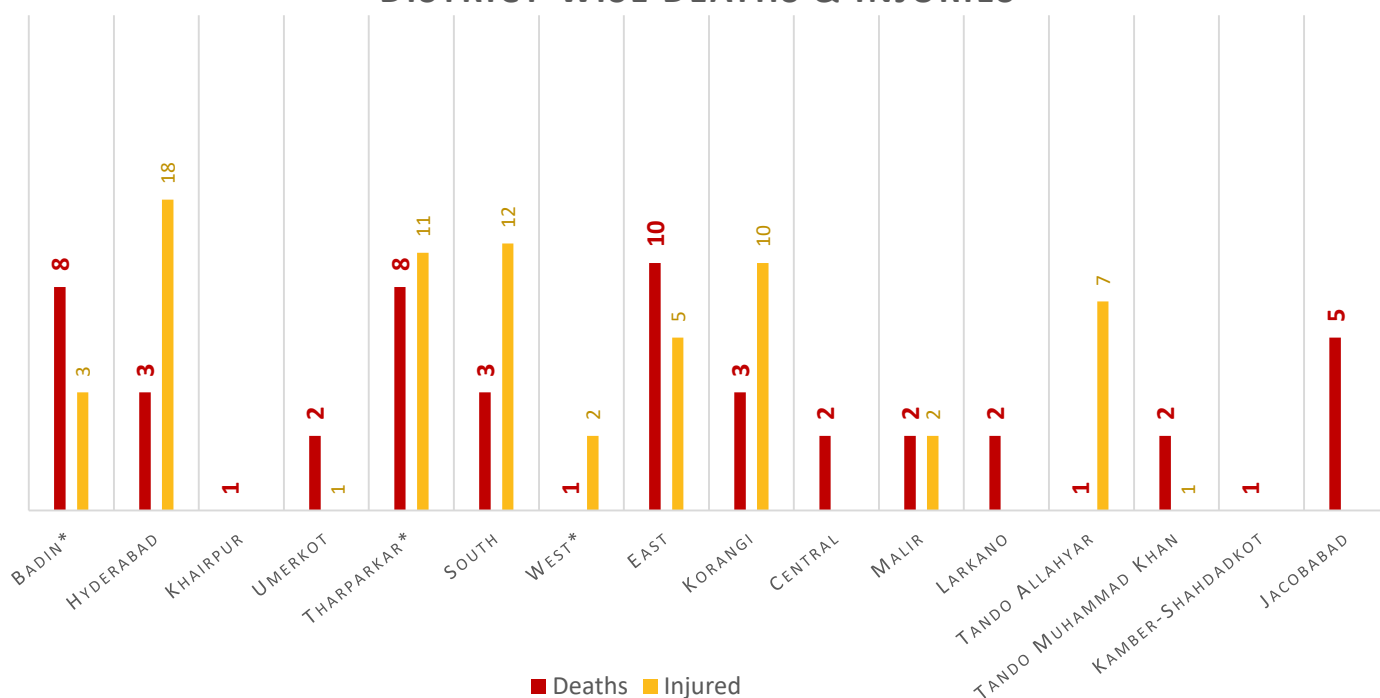

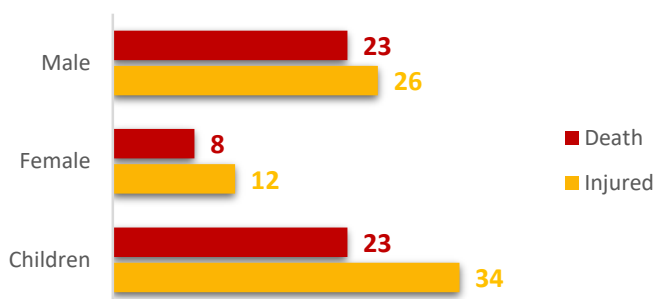

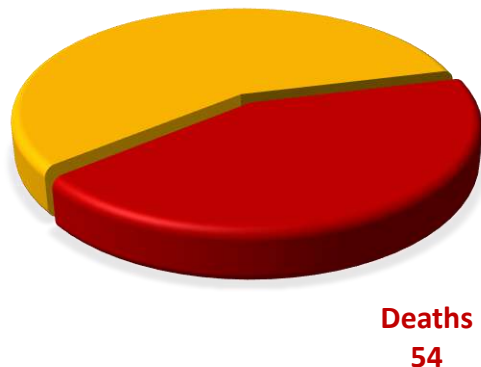
DISTRICT-WISE DEATHS & INJURIES

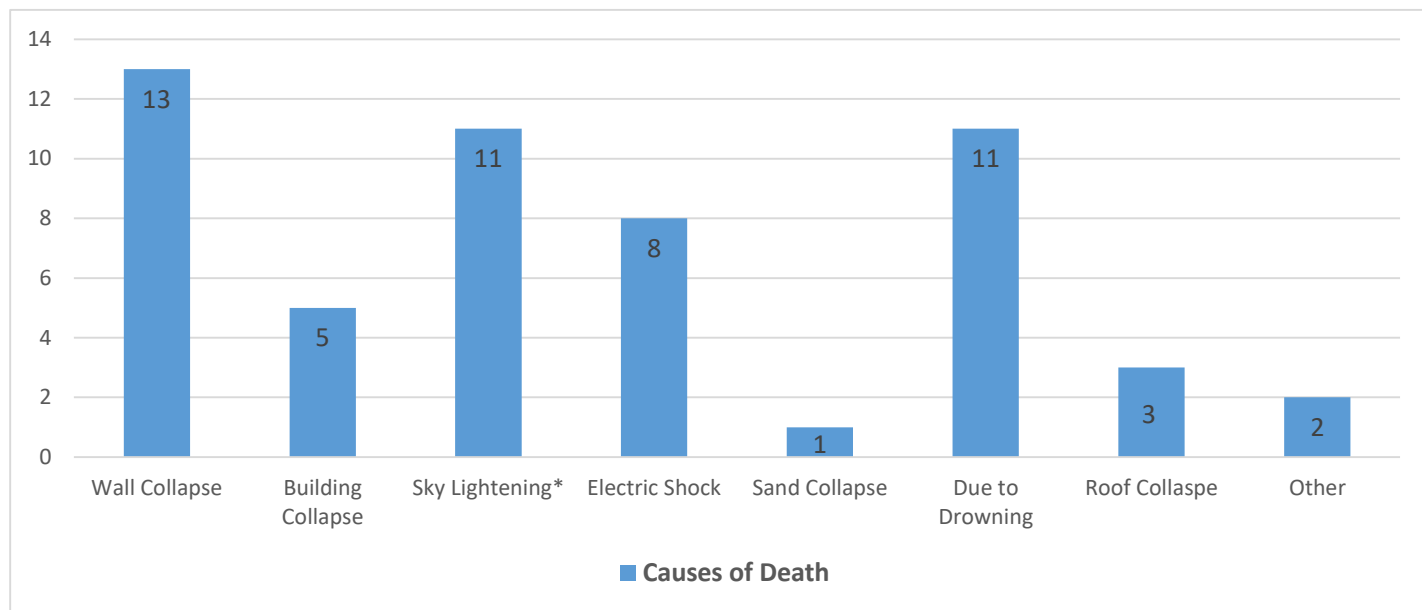

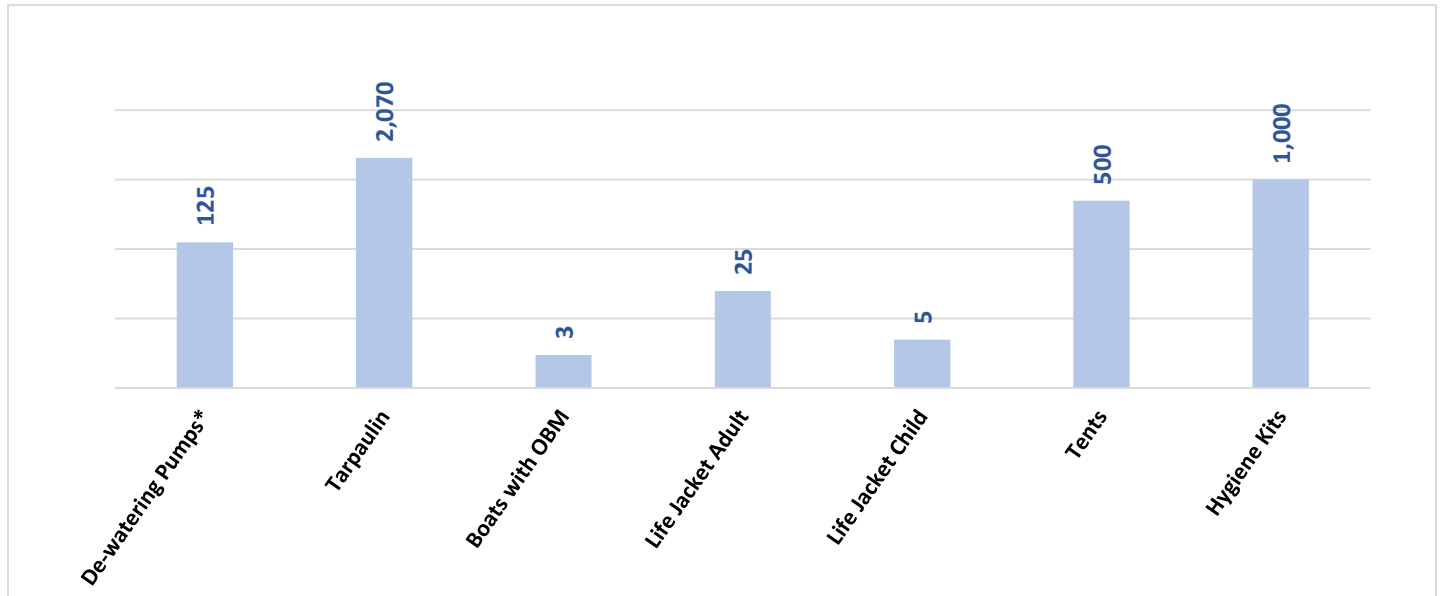
