**Subject: STRONG MONSOON CURRENTS FROM THE ARABIAN SEA ARE CONTINUOUSLY
PENETRATING IN SOUTHERN & CENTRAL PARTS OF THE COUNTRY**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that yesterday's low pressure over Southwest Rajasthan and adjoining areas persist. Due to this strong monsoon currents from the Arabian Sea are continuously penetrating in southern & central parts of the country. Under the influence:

- **Thunderstorm/rain** with a **few moderate to isolated heavy falls** likely in Tharparkar, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Sanghar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Hyderabad, Matiari, Jamshoro & Shaheed Benazirabad districts till **27th July** with occasional gaps.
- **Dust-thunderstorm/rain** of light to moderate intensity also likely in Ghotki, Kashmore, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Sukkur, Kambar Shahdadkot, Larkana, Khairpur, Nosheroferoz & Thatta districts till **27th July** with occasional gaps.
- Mostly cloudy conditions with chances of Thunderstorm/rain at outskirts, while light rain/drizzle likely in Karachi.

Possible Impacts & Advice:

- **Windstorm & lightning may damage weak structures (solar panels, electric poles, bill boards etc.) during the forecast period.**
- **Heavy rainfall may generate urban flooding in Tharparkar, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Sanghar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Hyderabad, Matiari & Shaheed Benazirabad districts during forecast period.**
- **Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.**
- **Prevailing hot and humid conditions are likely to subside during the forecast period.**
