**Subject: MONSOON CURRENTS FROM ARABIAN SEA & BAY OF BENGAL ARE
CONTINUOUSLY AFFECTING THE UPPER AND CENTRAL PARTS OF PAKISTAN**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that the Deep Depression has weakened into a **Depression** and now lies over South Madhya Pradesh (India). Under the influence of this system, monsoon currents from the Arabian Sea and the Bay of Bengal are continuously affecting the upper and central parts of Pakistan. A westerly wave also affecting northern areas, which is likely to strengthen and affect upper and central parts of the country. Under the influence of this weather system:

- **Dust-thunderstorm/Rain** with a **few moderate to isolated heavy to very heavy falls** likely in Tharparkar, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Sanghar, Khairpur, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Hyderabad, Matiari, & Shaheed Benazirabad districts. While **Dust-thunderstorm/Rain** of **moderate intensity** likely in Ghotki, Kashmore, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Sukkur, Kamber Shahdadkot, Larkano, Naushahro Feroze, Thatta & Jamshoro districts from **today (evening/night) to 03rd August** with occasional gaps.
- **Dust-thunderstorm/Rain** of **light to moderate intensity** in **Karachi division** from **tomorrow (afternoon/evening) to 03rd August** with occasional gaps.

Possible Impacts and advises:

- **Heavy rains may cause Urban flooding in low lying areas of Sukkur, Shaheed Benazirabad, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Sanghar, Khairpur, Mithi, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar from 31st July to 02nd August.**
- **Heavy rains, Windstorm & lightning may damage weak structures (solar panels, electric poles, bill boards etc.) during the forecast period.**
- **Tourists and travelers are advised to remain extra cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.**
- **Stay indoor unless absolutely necessary. Keep doors and windows shut and avoid sitting near windows as rain is often accompanied by strong winds.**
- **Maintain a distance from power lines or electrical wires. If you notice any loose electric wires in your area, alert the concerned authorities immediately.**
- **Avoid touching electrical switches or outlets while it is raining. Do not try using electrical sockets or outlets outdoors while it is raining.**
- **Avoid driving in heavy rain because of poor visibility.**
- **Avoid underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects.**
- **Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.**

2. Keeping in view above, it is requested that concerned Deputy Commissioners / Chairman DDMA's and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures.

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain "Vigilant" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward Situation during the forecast period.
