Subject: **RAIN-WIND/THUNDERSTORM IS EXPECTED IN UPPER SINDH**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a westerly wave is likely to approach western parts of the country on 25th January (Sunday) and likely to grip upper parts of the country on 26th January. Under the influence of this weather system:

- **Rain-wind/thunderstorm** is expected in Upper Sindh (Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Dadu) on **26th January**.

Possible Impacts & advises:

- **Tourists are advised to remain extra cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.**
- **Day time temperatures are likely to drop significantly during the period.**

2. Keeping in view above, it is requested that all concerned Deputy Commissioners / Chairman DDMA and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures.

More rain/snowfall predicted in the country from Sunday (night) to Tuesday

A westerly wave is likely to approach western parts of the country on 25th January (Sunday) and likely to grip upper parts of the country on 26th January. Under the influence of this weather system:

- **Rain-wind/thunderstorm with Snowfall** is expected in Balochistan (Quetta, Ziarat, Chaman, Pishin, Qilla Abdullah, Qilla Saifullah, Noushki, Harnai, Zhob, Kalat, Barkhan, Sibbi, Loralai, Turbat, Gawadar, Jiwani, Kech, Awaran, Chaghi, Panjgur, Khuzdar, Washuk and Kharan) on **25th (night) and 26th January**, and Upper Sindh (Sukkar, Larkana, Jacobabad, Dadu) on **26th January**.
- **Rain-wind/thunderstorm with snowfall (few heavy snowfall)** is also expected in Gilgit-Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ganche, Shigar), Kashmir (Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Rawalakot, Haveli), Chitral, Dir, Swat, Kalam, Shangla, Kohistan, Battagram, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Buner, Peshawar, Nowshera, Swabi, Malakand, Mardan, Kohat, Kurram, Khyber, Hangu, Bajur, Bannu, Dera Ismail Khan, Waziristan, Murree, Galliyat, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Chakwal, Attock, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Gujrat Sargodha, Mianwali, Gujranwala, Multan, Layyah, Bhakkar, Dera Ghazi Khan on **26th and 27th January** with occasional gaps.
- **Possible Impacts and advises:**
 - Heavy snowfall may cause road closure/ slippery conditions in Naran, Kaghan, Dir, Swat, Kalam, Chitral, Kohistan, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Shangla, Astore, Hunza, Skardu, Murree, Galliyat, Neelum valley, Bagh, Poonch, Haveli, Quetta, Ziarat, Chaman, Pishin, Qilla Abdullah, Qilla Saifullah, Noushki, Harnai and Zhob from 26th to 27th January.
 - Possibility of the landslides/avalanche in hilly areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir during the period.
 - Tourists are advised to remain extra cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.
 - Day time temperatures are likely to drop during the period.

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain “Vigilant” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward Situation during the forecast period.

اتوار (رات) سے منگل تک ملک کے مختلف علاقوں میں مزید بارش اور برفباری کی پیشگوئی

محکمہ موسیات کی پیشگوئی کے مطابق ایک مغربی ہواں کا سلسلہ 25 جنوری (اتوار) کو ملک کے مختلف علاقوں میں داخل ہونے کا مکان ہے، جو 26 جنوری کو ملک کے بالائی علاقوں کو اپنی پیش میں لے گا۔ اس موسمی نظام کے زیر اثر:

- 25 (رات) اور 26 جنوری کے دوران بلوچستان (کوئٹہ، زیارت، چمن، پشین، قلعہ عبداللہ، نوٹھی، ہر نائی، ژوب، قلات، بارکھان، سی، لور الائی، تربت، گوار، جیوانی، کچ، آواران، چاغی، پیشگوئی، خضدار، وائٹ اور خاران) میں تیز ہواں اور گرنج چمک کے ساتھ بارش جبکہ بالائی علاقوں میں برفباری کا مکان ہے۔ 26 جنوری کو بالائی سندھ (سکھر، لازکانہ، جیکب آباد، دادو) میں بھی بارش / تیز ہواں اور گرنج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا مکان ہے۔
- 26 اور 27 جنوری کے دوران گلگت بلتستان (دیامر، استور، غذر، اسکردو، ہنزہ، گلگت، گاٹھپے، شگر)، کشمیر (وادی نیلم، مظفر آباد، پونچھ، بھیاں، باغ، راولکوٹ، ہولی)، چترال، دیر، سوات، کالام، شانگلہ، کوہستان، بیکری، مانسہرہ، ایبٹ آباد، بتوں، پشاور، نو شہر، صوابی، مالکانہ، مردان، کوہاٹ، کرم، خیبر، پیشگوئی، بامجوڑ، بتوں، ڈیرہ اسماعیل خان، وزیرستان، مری، گلیات، اسلام آباد، راولپنڈی، چکوال، اٹک، منڈی ہبھاڑ الدین، سیالکوٹ، نارووال، لاہور، شیخوپورہ، گجرات، سرگودھا، میانوالی، گوجرانوالہ، ملتان، لیہ، بھکر اور ڈیرہ غازی خان میں تیز ہواں اور گرنج چمک کے ساتھ وققے و قفقے سے بارش جبکہ بالائی علاقوں میں برفباری (چند مقلات پر شدید برفباری) کا بھی امکان ہے۔

مکمل اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- 26 جنوری (رات) سے 27 جنوری کے دوران شدید برفباری کے باعث ناران، کاغان، دری، سوات، کالام، چترال، کوہستان، مانسہرہ، ایبٹ آباد، شانگلہ، استور، ہنزہ، اسکردو، مری، گلیات، وادی نیلم، باغ، پونچھ، ہولی، کوئٹہ، زیارت، چمن، پشین، قلعہ عبداللہ، نوٹھی، ہر نائی اور ژوب میں سڑکوں کے بند ہونے اور پھولن کی وجہ سے ٹیک کی روائی میں خلل کا اندیشہ۔
- بالائی خیبر پختونخوا، کشمیر اور گلگت بلتستان کے پہاڑی علاقوں میں لینڈ سلائیڈنگ / بر قانی توڑے کرنے کا خطرہ۔
- اس دوران سیاحوں کو محتاط رہنے اور غیر ضروری سفر سے احتیاط کی بولیت۔
- اس دوران دن کے درج حرارت میں کمی متوقع۔

نوت: تمام متعلقہ اداروں کو "الرت" رہنے اور کسی ناخواہکوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی بولیت کی جاتی ہے۔
