Karachi 8<sup>th</sup> October 2018: PDMA Sindh celebrated National Resilience Day today at DABeach View Park near Sea View, Karachi. The day is celebrated in commemoration of Earthquake 2005 victims. The Advisor to Chief Minister Sindh for Information and Archives, Law, Enquiries and Anticorruption Department, Barrister Murtaza Wahab graced the occasion as Chief Guest and highlighted the importance of awareness for Disaster Resilience. He stressed upon educating the people for recurring disasters like heat waves, droughts and floods. The honorable Advisor said that we need to adopt modern/ international best practices for mitigation, rescue, relief & rehabilitation.

The Secretary Rehabilitation/DG PDMA, Mr. Akhtar Hussain Bugti, other high officials from Government of Sindh and a number of representatives of civil society, NGOs, electronic and print media participated in the event.

The Secretary Rehabilitation highlighting the importance of the day in his speech said that the Government of Sindh has been taking concrete steps to minimize the effects of natural as well as humanmade disasters.
