The meeting of the Procurement Committee for purchase of relief items for PDMA Sindh was held under the Chairman PC, Deputy Director (F&A), PDMA Sindh in PDMA Head office Karachi on 08.01.2018 at 11:30 pm. List of the participants is attached.


2. The Chair welcomed the participants to the meeting. The Chair apprised the participants that any disaster / emergency may approach therefore, it is imperative that the PDMA is fully endowed with requisite materials to meet the challenges ahead. The committee was also informed that the Headquarter Engineering 5-Corps has already placed its demand to the PDMA. To meet the same, PDMA initiating a tendering process against the items approved in 12th Board meeting. In this regards, a fresh tender is being floated for the said items. During the course of meeting it was further apprised that the main purpose of this meeting was to finalize specification of the goods, quantity mentioned therein, the bidding document, date of publication of NIT, last date of collection of bid documents, last date of submission of bids and opening of tender, tender fees and method of procurement.


3. A draft bidding document that includes all ToRs and detailed specification was placed before the PC, which was examined and discussed at length. It was also pointed out that the Bidding Document were finalized in light of the past experience. The PC, after deliberations, took the following decisions:


- i. Procurement of relief goods as per NIT with specification and was minutely examined.
- ii. The bidding documents was also minutely examined and the PC was unanimously finalized and agreed upon which may be perused at "Annexure -A".
- iii. The draft Tender Notice was also examined and unanimously approved by PC.
- iv. The PC decides the dates of publication of Tender Notice, Last date of collection of bid documents, the last date of submission of bid and Date of opening of tender.
- v. The tender fee was finalized at Rs.3000/- non refundable for each item / relief package.
- vi. The tender will be single stage two envelopes.

- vii. Tender will be opened at PDMA Head office Karachi i.e. Bunglow No. 82, Lane No. 10, Khayaban-e-Hilal, DHA, Phase-VI, Karachi.
- viii. Bid evaluation criteria available on SPPRA website was examined and decided for adherence while evaluating the proposals.
- ix. The successful bidder will have to deposit performance guarantee to the tune of 5% of the quoted value at the time of award of contract.
- x. A Technical Sub Committee will be constituted for Technical evaluation/ assessment of the tendered items. The service of any concerned agency / co-opted member may be hired for this purpose. One or more sub committees / labs may be constituted to verify the quality of the stocks as per technical evaluation and assessment report of the samples, by the subcommittee / labs.
- xi. The PC will start evaluating technical proposals following the next day of opening of tender.
4. The meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the Chair.




MINUTES OF THE MEETING FOR OPENING OF TECHNICAL BID OF PROCUREMENT COMMITTEE
FOR PROCUREMENT OF RELIEF ITEMS/ GOODS 2017-18 HELD ON 13TH APRIL, 2018
TENDER (SPPRA ID#37404) OF PDMA SINDH.

A meeting of the Procurement Committee constituted in pursuance of rule 7 of the SPPR Rule-2010 and notified vide No. SO-I(Rehab)/3-14/2014/177, dated:03.01.2018 regarding purchase of relief items/ goods/ equipments was held under the Chairpersonship of Mr. Zain-ul-Abideen Ansari, Deputy Director (F&A), PDMA Sindh/ Chairman PC, on 13th April, 2018 at PDMA Head office Karachi at 03:30 p.m. for Opening of tenders as per schedule communicated vide NIT published in leading daily newspapers, and hoisted on PDMA website and SPPRA website (SPPRA ID# 37404).

The chair welcomed and apprised the participants that only the technical proposals will be opened in the presence of the bidders and the procurement Committee will technically evaluate the initial criteria of the bidders in their presence on the prescribed Proforma and the bidders qualifying in the initial scrutiny will be evaluated further by the Procurement committee in due course of time and will also be subject to sample/ catalogue testing through technical sub committees & Laboratory. The Financial proposals of only those bidders who qualify successfully in the Final technical evaluation criteria will be opened. The Chairperson PC apprised the committee that 32 vendors/ bidders obtained the bidding documents from PDMA Head office, Karachi on submission of non refundable tender fee amounting to Rs.3000/- per item/Package. It was further apprised that 10 bids have been received from bidders who downloaded the Bidding Documents and have submitted their proposals accompanied by Tender Fee vide Pay orders before closing time of submission of bid i.e. 02:30pm, making the total bids to 110. However, on the scheduled date only 88 bidders have participated in bidding process. The attendance sheets of the PC & bidders are attached as **Annexure-1 to 3**.

As decided earlier in the first Procurement Committee meeting held on 08.01.2018, the bidding process was single stage two envelope as per (Rules 46(2) of SPP Rules-2010 amended in 2017), hence the bids were opened in front of bidders / representatives, whereby the technical proposals were opened and financial bids were kept in safe custody. The Technical proposals which were opened in front of the bidders were evaluated then and there through the initial technical evaluation criteria to maintain transparency and equality. The proposals were opened for all the tendered items of NIT.

It was also decided by the Procurement Committee that since sample testing/ catalogue evaluation of the items/equipments is involved, hence all the items will be further evaluated by the technical subcommittees and the specialized laboratories. Procurement Committee, therefore decided as under:



**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF PROCUREMENT COMMITTEE REGARDING FINANCIAL EVALUATION FOR
PROCUREMENT OF RELIEF ITEMS/ GOODS 2017-18 HELD ON 23.05.2018 (SPPRA ID# 37404).**

A meeting of procurement committee of PDMA Government of Sindh was held on 23.05.2018 at 10:30 am in the committee room of PDMA Sindh under the Chairman of Mr. Zain-ul-Abideen Ansari, Deputy Director (F&A), PDMA Sindh/ Chairperson PC and in the presence of the bidders who were technically qualified in the "Final Technical Evaluation Criteria". The Attendance sheet of the participants and the bidders is attached at Annexure- I&II.

In the light of decision of technical sub committees-I&II, lab reports & Final Technical Evaluation Criteria Report (Annexure-A), financial bids of Nine (09) successful firms / contractors were opened for various items / packages on the above mentioned date & time.

Furthermore, there was only one technically qualified bidder for the NIT Relief Package No 1, Relief Package 3, Relief Package 4, Water Proof Torch, Fiber Glass Boats, OBM 40 HP, Ladders, Life Ring/ Buoy, Generator 35KVA, Anchor for which the quoted prices were compared with the previous procured rates (Work Orders) & market price of the items/ equipments which was found acceptable by the Procurement Committee.

Moreover, there was a single bidder initially qualified for the Items No.22 Search Light M/s Star Enterprises which was rejected in the "Final Technical Evaluation Report" by the TSC-I (Sample did not complied to the specification of NIT), therefore no bid was opened for Item No. 22 Searchlight.

The Procurement Committee unanimously decided that the item / Package wise required quality and specifications mentioned in the tender documents for purchase of relief goods 2017-18 would be strictly complied. The comparative statement of rates of firms is placed at Annexure-B. The detail of the firms whose financial bids were opened and their quoted rates are as under:
