A meeting of the Procurement Committee of PDMA was held on 17th July, 2014 at PDMA Office at 11 AM under the chairmanship of Chairman Procurement Committee i.e. Director (F&A) PDMA Sindh for appraisal of the financial bids opened on 14.07.2014 for the procurement of relief articles ahead of monsoon 2014. The following members of the Procurement Committee were present:

The consolidated bids offered for each of the relief article by the bidders of the respective good were placed before the Committee to review and recommend the lowest qualifying bidder for each of the relief good. The consolidated bids are attached at Annex-A.

The Committee also reviewed the results of the samples of tents, plastic sheets, mosquito nets, water purifying filters and dewatering pumps provided by NED University and to attain utter satisfaction as if whether the lowest bidder will be able to perform the contract satisfactorily or otherwise, the Committee under ITB No. 27, and its associated points revisited the technical, financial and production capabilities.



The Committee in the light of above said ITB observed as under:

(i) The sample of tent provided by M/s Pearl Associates was not in accordance with the specifications mentioned in NIT as mentioned by NED in their Assessment Report.

(ii) The samples of Plastic Sheets provided by Pearl Associates, Hussain Enterprises, National Tents, Worldwide Logistics, Star Traders, Al Nusrah Intl were under sized as well as under-weight as mentioned by NED in their Assessment Report.

(iii) The samples of mosquito nets provided by Pearl Associates, Hussain Enterprises, Star Traders, Alizeh Enterprises were under sized as well as the mesh size was not in accordance with the specified limits as mentioned by NED in their Assessment Report.

(iv) Hussain Enterprises NTN was not found duly registered in the name of the company but as an Individual which according to the Committee was not admissible and the financial and business criteria set by the profile of the company was not found upto the mark.

Based on the above, the Committee decided and recommended as under:

- A. **Tents:** since the lowest firms i.e. Pearl and Hussain failed to comply the specified instructions, hence High Tech being the next lowest and technically and financially responsive was recommended for award of contract for tents.
- B. **Plastic Sheets:** since none of the firms came upto be technically and financially responsive, hence the Committee recommends to cancel the award of contract as regards plastic sheets.
- C. **Mosquito Nets:** Nokon International was recommended for award of contract of mosquito nets as Star Traders though lowest, but failed to meet the specifications of size and mesh criteria.
- D. **Jerry Cans:** Star Traders being the lowest was recommended to be awarding contract.
- E. Water Purifying Filter: The Committee recommended Grace Intl for award of contract for procurement of water purifying filters.
- F. **Dewatering Pumps:** only two companies participated and both companies offered bids for 20 HP, whereas only one firm submitted bid for 40 HP. The committee recommends Flow Pak Pump Industries for being lowest for award of contract for procurement of 20 HP pumps and Meraj Limited may be considered for award of contract for it was the only bidder in 40 HP pumps.
- G. **Transport:** M/s Ideal Cargo was lowest in almost all the routes and vehicles contrary to M/ Karachi Sitara Hilal goods Co. Therefore the Committee recommended for award of contract to M/s Ideal Transport Co.
- H. **GPS Based Trackers:** Since only one firm participated and that even did not qualify technically, hence, the Committee recommended to cancel the procurement of trackers in the said procurement process.



The Committee further decided to submit their recommendations to the Director General PDMA in the form of a comprehensive Bid Evaluation Report which is also mandatory for hoisting on SPPRA's website.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.
