




The meeting of the Consultant Selection Committee regarding consultancy services for conducting baseline / feasibility study for seismic, tsunami and cyclone hazards along coast of Sindh and identification of suitable sites for installation of multi-hazard early warning system was held under the Chairman CSC, Director (Ops), PDMA Sindh in PDMA Head office Karachi on 6th June 2023 at 15:00 Hours. Attendance of the committee is attached.


2. The Chair welcomed the participants to the meeting. The Chair apprised the participants that only two proposals/ bids have been received till to date after the publication of the RFP. After the scrutiny / evaluation of the proposals only one firm namely (NESPAK) is qualified and another Firm Namely **BM Consultant Engineers (Pvt) Ltd** were found technically disqualified due to non-adhering to the Basic Eligibility Criteria hence were not eligible for further evaluation. The CSC recommended that Financial opening meeting may be convene.



2. The Chair welcomed the participants to the meeting. The Chair apprised the participants that only two proposals/ bids have been received and proposals were opened in the presence of the participants and were informed that the proposals will be thoroughly scrutinized in due course of time. After the scrutiny / evaluation of the proposals only one firm namely M/s National Engineering Services Pakistan (Pvt) Limited (NESPAK) is qualified and another Firm namely M/s BM Consultant Engineers (Pvt) Ltd were found technically disqualified due to non-adhering to the Basic Eligibility Criteria hence were not eligible for further evaluation.
3. MS/ NESPAK quoted Rate is Rs.15,000,000/- which were found acceptable in accordance to the PC-I cost of the said Scheme.
4. The CSC recommended M/s NESPAK for the Award of Contract for being the single qualified bidder in the said tender on the basis of merit under Rule 48 of SPPRA 2010 (amended 2019).
