**MINUTES OF THE PRE-BID MEETING OF THE PROCUREMENT COMMITTEE HELD ON 26<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2026 AT 1200 HOURS FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF RELIEF ITEMS / GOODS AND EQUIPMENT FOR CFY 2025-26**

A meeting of the Procurement Committee, notified vide letter No. SO-I(Rehab)/3-14/2014/5540 dated 01.07.2025, for procurement of Works, Services, and Goods for FY 2025-26 for PDMA Sindh, was held under the chairmanship of Deputy Director (HQ&C), PDMA Sindh at PDMA Headquarters, Karachi, on 26.03.2026 at 12:00 PM. The list of participants is attached as (Annexure-A).

2. The meeting commenced with a welcome address by the Chair. It was informed that the Provincial Disaster Management Authority (PDMA), Sindh intends to initiate procurement of relief items, goods, equipment, and services required for preparedness and timely response to emergencies, including monsoon, floods and other natural disasters.

3. The Committee was further informed that, in pursuance of the decision taken in the 23rd PDMA Board Meeting held on 09.03.2026, approval was accorded for initiation of procurement of the following items: (Annex-B)

4. It was apprised that, in accordance with the decision of the 23rd Board Meeting, procurement of items at S. No. 2 to 5 shall be carried out through a competitive bidding process. With regard to Item No. 1 (Repair and Maintenance of Boats and OBMs), it was decided that a comprehensive assessment be conducted prior to procurement and works falling under warranty shall be undertaken through the original suppliers under warranty, while the remaining work shall be executed through a competitive bidding procedure (Annex-B).

5. In compliance thereof, PDMA Sindh constituted an Assessment Committee vide Order No. PDMA(s)/AD(Admin)/Misc/25-26/247 dated 11.03.2026. The Committee conducted physical inspections in accordance with its Terms of Reference and examined the items and submitted its report, placed at Annexure-D.

6. The Assessment Committee carried out a detailed verification of the condition of boats and Outboard Motors (OBMs) and identified the requirement for repair and maintenance of boats, along with general overhauling of OBM engines, including replacement of essential components. It was further observed that engine oil and other consumables require replacement to ensure operational readiness. The Committee also recommended revision of the estimated cost from Rs. 60 million to Rs. 56.9 million.


7. It was further apprised that only 08 generators (10 KVA capacity) are currently available with PDMA, which is insufficient to meet operational and emergency requirements. In view of this shortfall, procurement of 25 KVA generators is considered necessary to enhance operational capacity. Furthermore, as per the guidelines of the National Disaster Management Authority Stockpile Policy, PDMA Sindh is required to maintain a stock of 500 generators (>10 KVA capacity); however, the current availability is significantly below the prescribed level, necessitating immediate procurement.


8. The Committee was informed that, upon requisition by the Chairmen of District Disaster Management Authorities (DDMAs), PDMA provides dewatering pumps and rescue vehicles to various districts, and recent assessments have revealed that several of these assets have become non-operational or require maintenance due to prolonged usage and normal wear and tear; therefore, there is an urgent need to undertake repair and maintenance, along with procurement of necessary spare parts and miscellaneous items, to ensure their functionality and operational readiness for upcoming emergency situations.

9. It was further discussed that there is an acute shortage of Pallets and Racks required for proper stacking and storage of relief items in warehouses, which necessitates immediate procurement.



11. The Committee was apprised that the purpose of the pre-bid meeting was to finalize:


- Technical Specifications
- Bidding Documents
- Tender Schedule (publication, submission, and opening)
- Procurement method and tender fee

11. The draft bidding documents, including TORs and detailed specifications, were presented and discussed. After detailed deliberation, the Procurement Committee unanimously decided as follows:

- i. The bidding documents were reviewed and approved (Annexure-E).
- ii. The Tender Notice (NIT) was reviewed and approved (Annex-F).
- iii. The schedule for publication, submission, and opening of bids through EPADS was finalized.
- iv. The tender fee was fixed at Rs.5,000/- (non-refundable) for each item/category.
- v. The procurement method shall be Single Stage - Two Envelope.
- vi. The tender shall be opened through EPADS at PDMA Headquarters, Karachi.
- vii. Procurement of items shall be carried out as per approved specifications and NIT.
- viii. The Bid Security (Earnest Money) shall be 03% of the allocated/estimated amount for each item.
- ix. The Performance Guarantee shall be 05% of the quoted amount for each item at the time of contract award.
- x. Technical evaluation shall commence on the next working day after bid opening.
- xi. The Tender Notice shall be published in three leading newspapers (English, Urdu & Sindhi) and uploaded on PDMA, SPPRA, and EPADS websites in accordance with government policy.


A meeting of the Procurement Committee constituted in pursuance of Rules 7 & 8 of the SPP Rules-2010 (amended from time to time) and notified vide notification No.SO-I(REHAB)/3-14/2014/5540, dated:01.07.2025 regarding procurement of Goods, Services and Works was held under the Chairmanship of Deputy Director (HQ&C), PDMA Sindh/Chairman PC, on 04<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 at PDMA Head Office Karachi at 1430 hours for opening of tenders as per the schedule communicated vide NIT published in leading daily newspapers i.e. The News, Daily Kawish & Daily Jang dated 17<sup>th</sup> April 2026, (INF-KRY.No.1468/2026), hoisted on PDMA website and SPPRA e-PADS portal (e-PADS ID # S-26040760924, S-26040760872, S-26040760904, S-26040760927).


The attendance sheet of the Procurement Committee members and participated bidders/firms are attached as (Annexure- A & B-I to B-IV).


2. After welcoming the participants, the Chair apprised them that as per NIT, the bidding process was based on Single Stage Two Envelope procedure as per (Rule 46(2) of SPP Rules-2010 (amended from time to time) and only the technical bids would be opened in the presence of the bidders or their representatives through the e-PADS portal. The Procurement Committee would then scrutinize the bids with respect to submission of tender fee, earnest money, compliance with the Single Stage Two Envelope procedure, receipt of samples and other mandatory requirements at the initial stage.


3. It was further informed to the participants that only those bidders who qualify during the initial scrutiny would be evaluated further by the Procurement Committee, and their samples would be subject to evaluation by a reputable third party inspection firm, with the evaluation fees to be borne by the respective bidders as stipulated in the bidding documents. The financial bids of only those bidders who successfully qualify under the technical evaluation criteria shall be opened through e-PADS, in accordance with the SPP Rules, 2010 (amended from time to time).

The Procurement Committee observed that M/s Rizwan Corporation submitted the bid security and tender fee (Pay Order) in the name of the Provincial Disaster Management Authority instead of the Provincial Disaster Management Fund, contrary to the requirements explicitly stipulated in the NIT and bidding documents. The Committee further noted that no designated account exists in the name of the Provincial Disaster Management Authority for submission of bid security and tender fee against the subject procurement. Accordingly, the bid was declared non-responsive and the bidder was disqualified in accordance with the provisions of the SPP Rules, 2010 (amended from time to time).


In the case of M/s Gujrat Steel (Pvt.) Ltd., the Procurement Committee found that the firm failed to provide the sample of the item as per the mandatory requirement of the NIT. The said requirement had already been communicated to all participating bidders at the time of bid opening. Accordingly, the bid was declared non-responsive at the initial stage, and the bidder was disqualified in accordance with the provisions of the SPP Rules, 2010 (amended from time to time).


**6. The PC, after deliberations, made the following decisions:**


- I. The Procurement Committee decided to consider 15 bids out of 20 bids, as 05 bids were disqualified at the initial stage of scrutiny due to non-compliance with the mandatory requirements of the NIT and bidding documents. The reasons for disqualification have been mentioned above.
- II. The Procurement Committee decided that samples of items, namely Generator (25 KVA), Pallets, and Racks, shall be referred to a reputable third-party inspection firm for inspection, technical evaluation, and quality assessment of the offered goods in accordance with the NIT specifications, with the prior approval of the competent authority of the Procuring Agency. Furthermore, post-inspection of the offered goods shall also be carried out by the reputable third-party inspection firm to verify the quality and quantity of the supplied goods in accordance with the NIT specifications.

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



- III. Moreover, the Procurement Committee recommended that the technical evaluation and quality assessment of the offered goods under the item 'Spare Parts Required for Repair and Maintenance of Dewatering Pumps, Emergency Rescue Vehicles, and Miscellaneous Items' shall initially be carried out by the Procurement Committee in accordance with the NIT specifications. Subsequently, post-inspection of all offered goods shall be referred to a reputable third-party inspection firm for further inspection, technical evaluation, and assessment of the quality and quantity of the offered goods in accordance with the NIT specifications.
- IV. The Procurement Committee decided to verify the bid security from the issuing authority in accordance with Rule 37(3) of the SPP Rules, 2010 (amended from time to time).
- V. The Procurement Committee decided to verify the active status of NTN and GST of the firms through the FBR portal.
- VI. It was decided that the detailed evaluation of the bidders' qualification reports for the above-mentioned procurement shall be carried out in the next meeting of the Procurement Committee, and the recommendations will then be finalized.
- VII. The Procurement Committee shall prepare a Technical Evaluation Report of the bidders. Only those bidders who qualify under the technical evaluation criteria shall be notified in advance of the date of financial bid opening, and their financial bids shall be opened in their presence, should they choose to attend as per SPP Rules, 2010 (amended from time to time). Those bidders who were declared non-responsive shall be informed accordingly.



A meeting of the Procurement Committee constituted in pursuance of Rules 7 & 8 of the SPP Rules, 2010 (amended from time to time) and notified vide Notification No.SO-I(REHAB)/3-14/2014/5540 dated 01.07.2025 regarding the procurement of Goods, Services and Works was held under the Chairmanship of the Deputy Director (HQ&C), PDMA Sindh / Chairman Procurement Committee, on 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 at PDMA Head Office Karachi at 1400 hours for evaluation of technical bids according to the NIT and bidding documents. 2. The Chair welcomed the participants and apprised the forum that the bidding process was carried out under Single Stage Two Envelope Procedure in accordance with Rule 46(2) of the SPP Rules, 2010 (amended from time to time). The technical bids submitted through e-PADS were opened on 04.05.2026 and scrutinized with respect to the mandatory requirements as prescribed in the NIT and bidding documents.


3. The Procurement Committee deliberated upon the technical evaluation/qualification reports of the participating bidders with reference to compliance of mandatory requirements, submission of valid bid security along with Tender Fee, provision of samples, responsiveness of bids and conformity with the bidding documents.


4. The Committee was apprised that, in the 2nd Procurement Committee meeting held on 04.05.2026 for the opening of bids, a total of twenty (20) bidders participated in the bidding process and during initial scrutiny process, five (05) bidders were declared non-responsive/disqualified. Among these, four (04) bidders were disqualified for submitting bid security in the shape of pay orders/bank guarantees in the name of the Provincial Disaster Management Authority instead of the Provincial Disaster Management Fund, as required under the NIT and bidding documents, while one (01) bidder was disqualified for failing to provide the mandatory sample of the item.

6. After detailed scrutiny and deliberation, the Procurement Committee observed that none of the participating bidders could qualify for the mandatory qualification and technical evaluation criteria as prescribed in the bidding documents/NIT for the above-mentioned procurement items. Moreover, as per the decision of the last Procurement Committee meeting, the active status of Income Tax and GST registration of the bidders was verified and found active. Furthermore, the submitted earnest money instruments were also verified from the issuing authorities and found genuine. Accordingly, no bidder was found technically responsive/qualified for further financial evaluation (BQRs are attached at Annexure-B-C-D-E).

7. In view of the above facts and circumstances, the Procurement Committee unanimously decided and recommended that the procurement process for the subject NIT may be cancelled under Rule 25 of the SPP Rules, 2010 (amended from time to time), in the interest of fairness and competition, as no bidder qualified in the bidders' qualification/technical evaluation reports.

8. The Procurement Committee further recommended that the procurement process may be re-tendered afresh under the relevant provisions of the SPP Rules, 2010 (amended from time to time), after incorporation of necessary improvements/clarifications in the bidding documents, wherever required, to ensure wider competition and participation of technically qualified bidders.


