

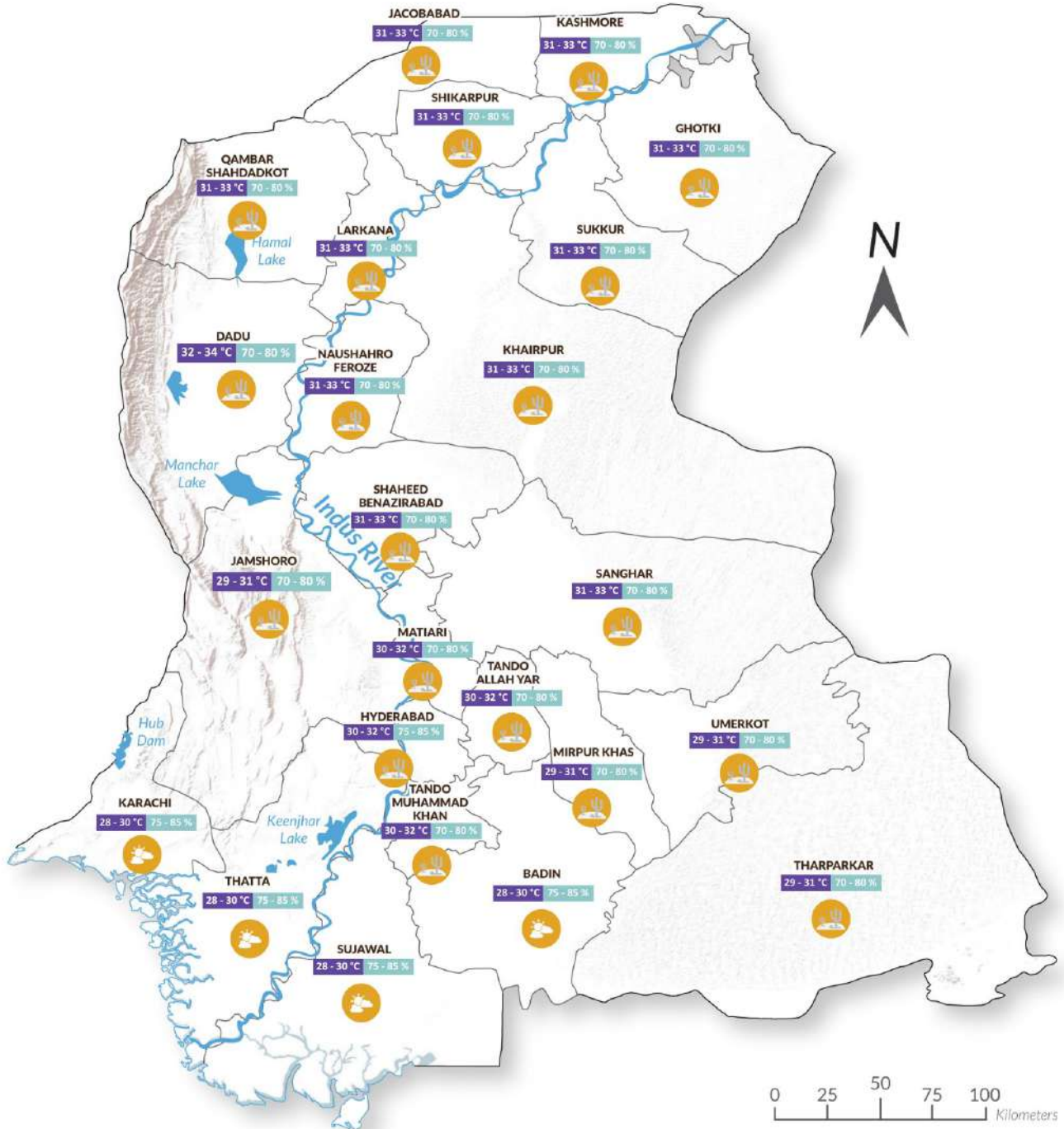

## Weather Forecast

### Weather Outlook:

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that **rain-wind/thundershower** is expected in **Sukkur, Larkano, Khairpur, Dadu, Jacobabad, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Tando Allahyar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tharparkar, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Sanghar** districts & **Karachi** division on **03<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> September** with occasional gaps.

### Possible Impacts:

- Heavy downpour/windstorm and lightning may affect damage weak structures like roof/wall of Kacha houses, electric poles, bill boards, vehicles, cause disruptions in the roads and solar panels etc. during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their activities keeping in view the weather forecast.
- Travelers and tourists are advised to remain extra cautious and manage their travelling according to weather conditions and avoid any untoward situation during the wet spell.

## Recommended Actions for DDMA's / Line Departments / Other Relevant Authorities

### Rainfall / Dust-storm / Wind-thunderstorm / Cyclonic Storm

- Conduct extensive public awareness campaigns through multiple channels, including TV/ broadcast / social / print media etc., to ensure that vulnerable communities are well-informed about the anticipated flood situation and necessary precautions.
- Enhance deployment of required machinery, equipment, emergency supplies and personnel in at-risk areas, considering on ground situation.
- Maintain sufficient stocks of essential supplies, including food, clean water, medical provisions, and sanitation supplies in case further emergent needs.
- Strategically position flood fighting equipment in areas prone to flooding, ensuring their availability for immediate deployment.
- Ensure timely cleaning / de-silting & maintenance of sewerage lines, storm water drains and nullahs.
- Ensure availability / functionality of all essential flood response equipment in flood-prone areas.
- Ensure full staffing / availability of trained emergency response personnel and designate their duties / areas of deployment in case of emergency.
- Conduct thorough reconnaissance of vulnerable locations, identifying critical infrastructure / communities that may require additional support and protection.
- Inform and sensitize residents of low-lying areas / at-risk communities of anticipated flood conditions, potential impacts, evacuation procedures and precautionary measures.
- Establish temporary shelters in safe locations for displaced individuals and ensure these are equipped with necessary supplies (food, clean drinking water, medical supplies and sanitation facilities).
- Ensure the availability of trained medical staff and ambulances in strategic locations to provide immediate medical assistance to those affected by floods.
- Implementing effective regulation strategies at headworks / barrages to optimize the discharge of excess water through irrigation channels.
- Proactive monitoring / maintenance / repairs of canal systems to enhance their capacity to handle increased flows.
- Undertake prompt repairs of any breaches / breaks in flood protective works.
- Inform travelers / tourists / in timely manner regarding anticipated weather / flood conditions, potential hazards, precautionary measures, and recommended alternative routes to regulate their travel and ensuring safety.
- Provide necessary assistance and support to travelers / tourists affected by flood situation, including evacuations if required.
- District Disaster Management Authorities (DDMA's) of flash flood prone districts are to maintain continued liaison with the DDMA's of districts of adjacent province to monitor the flow of water in streams and natural catchments.

## Precautionary Measures for General Public

### Rainfall / Dust-storm / Wind-thunderstorm / Cyclonic Storm

- Monitor the weather alerts through print media, electronic media, & social media.
- Stay indoor unless absolutely necessary. Keep doors and windows shut and avoid sitting near windows as rain is often accompanied by strong winds.
- Maintain a distance from power lines or electrical wires. If you notice any loose electric wires in your area, alert the authorities immediately.
- Avoid touching electrical switches or outlets while it is raining. Do not try using electrical sockets or outlets outdoors while it is raining.
- Avoid driving during heavy rain or dusty winds because of poor visibility.
- Avoid underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects.
- Check on family members who are especially at risk from weather hazards: young children, older adults, and the chronically ill.
- Avoid parking near walls, weak structures, under trees and billboards & hoardings that pose a danger to public safety.
- Residents of flash flood prone areas and coastal area are advised to remain informed and be prepared of possible evacuation during emergency situation.

**Rain-wind/thundershower is predicted in upper parts on 02<sup>nd</sup> and 03<sup>rd</sup> September.**

Met office informed that moist current from Bay of Bengal are likely to penetrate upper parts from 02<sup>nd</sup> September. A westerly wave is also likely to approach western parts of the country on 02<sup>nd</sup> September evening. Under the influence of this weather system: **Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa: Rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavyfalls)** are expected in Chitral, Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Shangla, Battagram, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Buner, Malakand, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Peshawar, Swabi, Nowshera, Mardan, Charsadda, Kurram, Orakzai, Kohat, Hangu, Bannu, Lakki Marwat, Waziristan and Dera Ismail Khan on **02<sup>nd</sup> & 03<sup>rd</sup> September.**

**Punjab/Islamabad: Rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavyfalls)** are expected in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Tala Gang, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sheikhpura, Sialkot, Narowal, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Khushab, Sargodha, Mianwali, Chiniot, Faisalabad, Okara, Pakpattan, Kasur and Bhakkar, on **02<sup>nd</sup> & 03<sup>rd</sup> September.** **Rain-wind/thundershower** is expected in Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Khanpur, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan, Layyah, Rajanpur and Rahimyar Khan on **03<sup>rd</sup> & 04<sup>th</sup> September** with occasional gaps.

**Kashmir: Rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavyfalls)** are expected in Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from **02<sup>nd</sup> (night) to 03<sup>rd</sup> September.**

**Gilgit-Baltistan:** Rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected in Gilgit-Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Skardu, Gilgit, Hunza, Ghanche, Shigar) on **02<sup>nd</sup> & 03<sup>rd</sup> September.**

**Balochistan:** Rain-wind/thundershower is expected in Quetta, Zhob, Sibi, Harnai, Ziarat, Kohlu, Barkhan, Loralai, Sherani, Qila Abdullah, Qila Saifullah, Khuzdar, Kalat, Naseerabad, Awaran and Lasbella from **02<sup>nd</sup> to 04<sup>th</sup> September with occasional gaps.**

**Sindh:** Rain-wind/thundershower is expected in Sukkur, Larkana, Khairpur, Dadu, Jacobabad, Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Tando Allahyar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tharparkar, Mithi, Mirpur Khas, Umarmkot and Sanghar on **03<sup>rd</sup> and 04<sup>th</sup> September with occasional gaps.**

**Possible Impacts and advises:**

- **Heavy rains** may increase flow in local nullas and streams in Murree, Galliyat, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Kohistan, Gilgit-Baltistan, Kashmir, Chitral, Dir, Swat, Shangla, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Nowshera, Swabi, Islamabad/Rawalpindi and Northeast Punjab on 02<sup>nd</sup> (night) and 03<sup>rd</sup> September.
- **Heavy Downpour** may cause **urban flooding** in low lying areas of Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sheikhpura, Kasur, Sialkot, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Nowshera and Peshawar on 02<sup>nd</sup> night and 03<sup>rd</sup> September.
- **Landslides** may disrupt roads in the vulnerable points of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Murree, Galliyat, Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan during the wet spell.
- **Moderate rains** may generate Landslides at vulnerable points and increase flows in local nullahs/streams of Kalat, Khuzdar, Barkhan on 03<sup>rd</sup> and 04<sup>th</sup> September.
- **Heavy downpour/windstorm** and lightning may affect damage weak structures like roof/wall of Kacha houses, electric poles, bill boards, vehicles, cause disruptions in the roads and solar panels etc. during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their activities keeping in view the weather forecast.
- Travelers and tourists are advised to remain extra cautious and manage their travelling according to weather conditions and avoid any untoward situation during the wet spell.

محکمہ موسمیات کے مطابق 02 ستمبر سے مرطوب ہوائیں خلیج بنگال سے ملک کے بالائی علاقوں میں داخل ہونے کا امکان ہے۔ جبکہ ایک مغربی لہر 02 ستمبر کی شام کو ملک کے مغربی حصوں پر اثر انداز ہو سکتی ہے۔ جس کے باعث:

**خیبر پختونخوا: 02 سے 03 ستمبر کے دوران:** چترال، دیر، سوات، کوہستان، شانگلہ، بگھرام، مانسہرہ، لیبت آباد، ہری پور، بونیر، مالاکنڈ، باجوڑ، مہمند، خیبر، پشاور، صوابلی، نوشہرہ، مردان، چارسدہ، کرم، اورکزئی، کوہاٹ، ہنگو، بنوں، کئی مروت و وزیرستان اور ڈیرہ اسماعیل خان میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر موسلا دھار بارش بھی متوقع۔

**پنجاب/اسلام آباد: 02 سے 03 ستمبر کے دوران:** اسلام آباد/راولپنڈی، مری، گلگت، انک، چکوال، تلنگ، جہلم، منڈی بہاؤ الدین، گجرات، گوجرانوالہ، لاہور، شیخوپورہ، سیالکوٹ، نارووال، حافظ آباد، وزیر آباد، ساہیوال، جھنگ، ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ، بنکانہ صاحب، خوشاب، سرگودھا، میانوالی، چنیوٹ، فیصل آباد، اوکاڑہ، پاکپتن، قصور اور بھکر میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر موسلا دھار بارش کی بھی توقع۔ جبکہ 03 سے 04 ستمبر کے دوران: بہاولپور، بہاولنگر، خان پور، ڈیرہ غازی خان، ملتان، لیہ، راجن پور اور رحیم یار خان میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش متوقع۔

**کشمیر: 02 ستمبر (رات) سے 03 ستمبر کے دوران:** کشمیر (واوی ٹیلم، مظفر آباد، راولا کوٹ، پونچھ، بیٹال، باغ، حویلی، سدھوتی، کوٹلی، جمبیر، میرپور) میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر موسلا دھار بارش کی بھی توقع۔

**گلگت بلتستان: 02 سے 03 ستمبر کے دوران:** گلگت بلتستان (دیامیر، استور، اسکردو، گلگت، ہنزہ، گھانچے اور شگر) میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔

**بلوچستان: 02 سے 04 ستمبر کے دوران:** کوئٹہ، ژوب، سی، ہرنائی، زیارت، کولہ، بارکھان، لورائی، شیرانی، قلعہ عبداللہ، قلعہ سیف اللہ، خضدار، قلات، نصیر آباد، آواران اور لسبیلہ اور میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔

**سندھ: 03 سے 04 ستمبر کے دوران:** سکھر، لاڈکانہ، خیرپور، دادو، جیکب آباد، کراچی، حیدر آباد، ٹھٹھہ، بدین، ٹنڈوالیہ، ٹنڈو محمد خان، تھر پارکر، مٹھی، میرپور خاص، عمرکوٹ اور ساگھڑ میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔

### محکمہ اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- **02 ستمبر (رات) سے 03 ستمبر کے دوران:** موسلا دھار بارش کے باعث مری، گلگت، مانسہرہ، کوہستان، چترال، گلگت بلتستان، دیر، سوات، شانگلہ، نوشہرہ، صوابلی، اسلام آباد/راولپنڈی، شمال مشرقی پنجاب اور کشمیر کے مقامی ندی نالوں میں پانی کے بہاؤ میں اضافے کا امکان۔
- **02 ستمبر (رات) سے 03 ستمبر کے دوران:** موسلا دھار بارش کے باعث اسلام آباد/راولپنڈی، گوجرانوالہ، لاہور، شیخوپورہ، قصور، سیالکوٹ، سرگودھا، فیصل آباد، نوشہرہ اور پشاور کے نشیبی علاقوں میں اربن فلڈنگ ہو سکتی ہے۔
- لینڈ سلائیڈنگ کی وجہ سے بالائی خیبر پختونخوا، مری، گلگت، کشمیر اور گلگت بلتستان کے علاقوں میں سڑکیں بند ہو سکتی ہیں۔
- **03 سے 04 ستمبر کے دوران:** بارشوں کے باعث قلات، خضدار، بارکھان کے مقامی ندی نالوں میں پانی کے بہاؤ میں اضافے اور لینڈ سلائیڈنگ کا خدشہ۔
- شدید بارشوں/آندھی/جھکڑ چلنے اور گرج چمک کے باعث روزمرہ کے معمولات متاثر ہونے، کمزور افراد سڑک پر (کچے گھر/دیواریں، کچی کے کھجے، پل بورڈز، گاڑیوں اور سولر پینل وغیرہ) کو نقصان اور سڑکوں کی بندش کا اندیشہ۔
- کسان حضرات موسمیاتی پیش گوئی کو مد نظر رکھتے ہوئے اپنے معمولات ترتیب دیں۔
- مسافروں اور سیاح حضرات سفر کے دوران زیادہ محتاط رہیں اور موٹی حالات کے مطابق اپنے سفر کا انتظام کریں اور بارشوں کے دوران کسی بھی ناخوشگوار صورتحال سے بچنے کے لیے موسم کے بارے میں آگاہی حاصل کریں۔
