

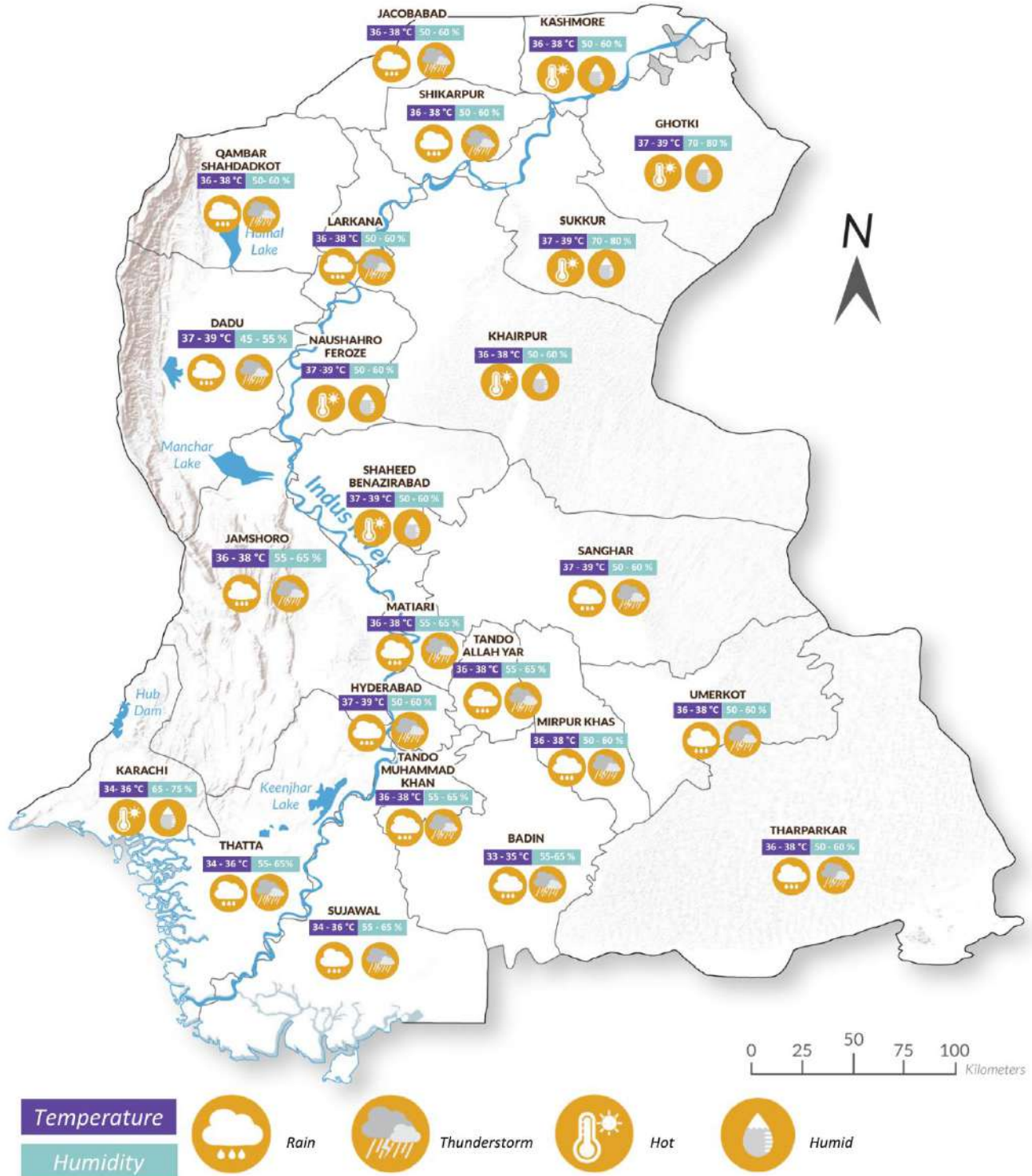

Weather Forecast

Weather Outlook:

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that yesterday's **well-marked low pressure** area located over central India moved westwards & intensifying into a **depression** over Madhya Pradesh (India) is likely to move west-southwestward during next 12 hours & may approach eastern Sindh on **today night/ 26th August morning**. Due to this weather system strong monsoon currents likely to enter in Sindh from **today night/ 26th August morning**. Under its influence:

- **Rain/ wind-thunderstorms** with **scattered heavy-very heavy to isolated extremely heavy falls** likely in **Tharparker, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Hyderabad, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Matiari, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Jamshoro, Dadu, Kambar Shahdadt, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, and Larkana** districts from **today night to 31st August** with occasional gaps.
- **Rain/ wind-thunderstorms** with **few heavy to isolated very heavy falls** likely in **Ghotki, Sukkur Khairpur, Kashmore, Naushahro Feroze, & Shaheed Benazirabad** districts during **26th to 30th August** with occasional gaps.
- **Wind-thunderstorm/ rain** with **scattered heavy to isolated very heavy falls** also occur in **Karachi Division** during **27th – 31st August** with occasional gaps.
- Flood Forecasting Division of Pakistan Meteorological Department has also informed that **Severe Flash Flooding** is likely to develop in the areas along Kirthar range, **Jacobabad, Kambar Shahdadt, Dadu & Jamshoro** districts from **27th to 31st August**. Urban Flooding is also expected in the metropolitan cities of Sindh. (**Bulletin No. C-072/24 dated: 25th Aug 2024, copy attached**)

Possible Impacts:

- **Heavy Falls** may cause water logging in low laying areas of all districts.
- **Torrential rains** over **Kirthar** and adjoining hill torrents of **Balochistan** may generate flash flooding in local Nullah's/ streams of **Dadu, Kambar Shahdadt, Jacobabad & Jamshoro** districts during forecast period.
- **Heavy downpour/windstorm** and lightning may affect daily routines, weak structures like roof/wall collapse of Kacha houses, electric poles, bill boards, vehicles and solar panels etc. during the forecast period.
- **Sea condition** remains rough to very rough during the forecast period.
- **Fishermen** are advised to remain careful and take the necessary precautions during the forecast period.



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Recommended Actions for DDMA's / Line Departments / Other Relevant Authorities

Rainfall / Dust-storm / Wind-thunderstorm:

- Conduct extensive public awareness campaigns through multiple channels, including TV/ broadcast / social / print media etc., to ensure that vulnerable communities are well-informed about the anticipated flood situation and necessary precautions.
- Enhance deployment of required machinery, equipment, emergency supplies and personnel in at-risk areas, considering on ground situation.
- Maintain sufficient stocks of essential supplies, including food, clean water, medical provisions, and sanitation supplies in case further emergent needs.
- Strategically position flood fighting equipment in areas prone to flooding, ensuring their availability for immediate deployment.
- Ensure timely cleaning / de-silting & maintenance of sewerage lines, storm water drains and nullahs.
- Ensure availability / functionality of all essential flood response equipment in flood-prone areas.
- Ensure full staffing / availability of trained emergency response personnel and designate their duties / areas of deployment in case of emergency.
- Conduct thorough reconnaissance of vulnerable locations, identifying critical infrastructure / communities that may require additional support and protection.
- Inform and sensitize residents of low-lying areas / at-risk communities of anticipated flood conditions, potential impacts, evacuation procedures and precautionary measures.
- Establish temporary shelters in safe locations for displaced individuals and ensure these are equipped with necessary supplies (food, clean drinking water, medical supplies and sanitation facilities).
- Ensure the availability of trained medical staff and ambulances in strategic locations to provide immediate medical assistance to those affected by floods.
- Implementing effective regulation strategies at headworks / barrages to optimize the discharge of excess water through irrigation channels.
- Proactive monitoring / maintenance / repairs of canal systems to enhance their capacity to handle increased flows.
- Undertake prompt repairs of any breaches / breaks in flood protective works.
- Inform travelers / tourists / in timely manner regarding anticipated weather / flood conditions, potential hazards, precautionary measures, and recommended alternative routes to regulate their travel and ensuring safety.
- Provide necessary assistance and support to travelers / tourists affected by flood situation, including evacuations if required.
- District Disaster Management Authorities (DDMA's) of flash flood prone districts are to maintain continued liaison with the DDMA's of districts of adjacent province to monitor the flow of water in streams and natural catchments.
- Remove all billboards and hoardings that pose a danger to public safety.

Precautionary Measures for General Public

Rainfall / Dust-storm / Wind-thunderstorm:

- Monitor the weather alerts through print media, electronic media, & social media.
- Stay indoor unless absolutely necessary. Keep doors and windows shut and avoid sitting near windows as rain is often accompanied by strong winds.
- Maintain a distance from power lines or electrical wires. If you notice any loose electric wires in your area, alert the authorities immediately.
- Avoid touching electrical switches or outlets while it is raining. Do not try using electrical sockets or outlets outdoors while it is raining.
- Avoid driving in heavy rain because of poor visibility.
- Avoid underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects.
- Check on family members who are especially at risk from weather hazards: young children, older adults, and the chronically ill.
- Avoid parking near walls, weak structures, under trees and billboards & hoardings that pose a danger to public safety.
- Residents of flash flood prone areas are advised to remain informed and be prepared of possible evacuation during emergency situation.

- آج رات سے 31 اگست کے دوران تھر پار کر، بدین، ٹھٹھہ، سجاول، حیدر آباد، ٹی ایم خان، ٹی اے یار، ٹھٹھہ، میر پور خاص، ساگھڑ، جامشور، دادو، قمبر شہدادکوٹ، جیکب آباد، شکار پور اور لاڑکانہ کے اضلاع میں وقفے وقفے سے گرج چمک۔ تیز ہواؤں کے ساتھ اکثر مقامات پر موسلا دھار سے شدید موسلا دھار اور چند مقامات پر انتہائی شدید موسلا دھار بارش کا امکان ہے۔
- 26 سے 30 اگست کے دوران گھوٹکی، سکھر، خیر پور، کٹنور، نوشہرہ فیروز اور شہید بینظیر آباد کے اضلاع میں وقفے وقفے سے گرج چمک۔ تیز ہواؤں کے ساتھ چند مقامات پر موسلا دھار اور کہیں کہیں شدید موسلا دھار بارش کا امکان ہے۔
- 27 سے 31 اگست کے دوران کراچی ڈویژن میں وقفے وقفے سے گرج چمک۔ تیز ہواؤں کے ساتھ اکثر مقامات پر موسلا دھار اور چند مقامات پر شدید موسلا دھار بارش کا امکان ہے۔

مکمل اثرات:

- موسلا دھار بارش کی وجہ سے تمام اضلاع کے نشیبی علاقوں میں پانی جمع ہو سکتا ہے۔
 - شدید بارشوں کے باعث کیرتھر اور لمحقہ بلوچستان کی پہاڑی ندی نالوں کی وجہ سے دادو، قمبر شہدادکوٹ، جیکب آباد اور جامشور کے اضلاع میں سیلابی صورتحال پیدا ہو سکتی ہے۔
 - شدید بارشوں/آندھی اور گرج چمک کے باعث روزمرہ کے معمولات متاثر ہونے، کمزور انفرا سٹرکچر (کچے گھر/دیواریں، بجلی کے کھمبے، بل بورڈز، سولر پنیل وغیرہ) کو نقصان کا اندیشہ۔
 - پیش گوئی کی مدت کے دوران سمندر میں طغیانی کا امکان ہے۔
 - مائی گیریوں کو مشورہ دیا جاتا ہے کہ وہ محتاط رہیں اور پیش گوئی کی مدت کے دوران ضروری احتیاطی تدابیر اختیار کریں۔

SUBJECT: -WEEKLY SIGNIFICANT WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR RIVERS' CATCHMENTS' (26th-August, 2024 to 01st-September, 2024)

➤ **RAINFALL OUTLOOK:**

Warning: Likely further intensification and westward movement of the strong weather system, widespread thunderstorm rain of **HEAVY TO VERY HEAVY** intensity with isolated **EXTREMELY HEAVY** falls may occur over **Sindh (all divisions) and Balochistan (Zhob, Sibbi, Nasirabad, Loralai, Kalat and Makran divisions) and South Punjab (DG Khan, Multan and Bahawalpur divisions)**, from 26th to 30th August.

➤ **FLOOD SITUATION IN MAJOR RIVERS:**

No significant increase is expected in the flows of any of the major rivers.

Alert (From 27th to 31st August):

SEVERE FLASH FLOODING is likely to develop in the areas along Kirthar ranges (Jacobabad, Qambar Shahdadkot, Dadu and Jamshoro districts) and Sulaiman ranges (DG Khan and Rajanpur districts) including nullahs in Balochistan (Zhob, Loralai, Sibbi, Nasirabad and Kalat division). Urban flooding is also expected in the metropolitan cities of Sindh.
