Weather Forecast

Weather Warning:

- Monsoon currents likely to enter in eastern Sindh from tomorrow evening. Under its influence Dust-thunderstorm/rain likely in Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Sanghar, Khairpur, Ghotki, Sukkur, Kashmore, Shikarpur, Dadu, Jacobabad, Larkano, Kamber Shahdadkot and Naushahro Feroze districts on 6th evening and 7th July.
- Hot & humid weather is likely to prevail most parts of the province, However, isolated drizzle may occur along the coast.

Weather Forecast

- Next 24 Hours: Mainly hot and humid weather with gusty winds may occur at some parts of upper Sindh of the province, whereas, partly cloudy with isolate drizzle may likely along the coast in Karachi.
- Next 48 Hours: Dust-thunderstorm/rain is likely in Tharparkar, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Khairpur, Ghotki, Sukkur, Kashmore, Shikarpur and Dadu, Jacobabad, Larkano, Kambar Shadadkot, Nausharo Feroze and Badin districts, whereas, hot and humid condition and partly cloudy with chances of light rain/drizzle along the coast.

Recommended Actions for DDMAs / Line Departments / Other Relevant Authorities

Rainfall / Dust-storm / Heavy Winds:

- Conduct extensive public awareness campaigns through multiple channels, including TV/ broadcast / social / print media etc., to ensure that vulnerable communities are well-informed about the anticipated flood situation and necessary precautions.
- Enhance deployment of required machinery, equipment, emergency supplies and personnel in at-risk areas, considering on ground situation.
- Maintain sufficient stocks of essential supplies, including food, clean water, medical provisions, and sanitation supplies in case further emergent needs.
- Strategically position flood fighting equipment in areas prone to flooding, ensuring their availability for immediate deployment.
- Ensure timely cleaning / de-silting & maintenance of sewerage lines, storm water drains and nullahs.
- Ensure availability / functionality of all essential flood response equipment in flood-prone areas.
- Ensure full staffing / availability of trained emergency response personnel and designate their duties / areas of deployment in case of emergency.
- Conduct thorough reconnaissance of vulnerable locations, identifying critical infrastructure / communities that may require additional support and protection.
- Inform and sensitize residents of low-lying areas / at-risk communities of anticipated flood conditions, potential impacts, evacuation procedures and precautionary measures.
- Establish temporary shelters in safe locations for displaced individuals and ensure these are equipped with necessary supplies (food, clean drinking water, medical supplies and sanitation facilities).
- Ensure the availability of trained medical staff and ambulances in strategic locations to provide immediate medical assistance to those affected by floods.
- Implementing effective regulation strategies at headworks / barrages to optimize the discharge of excess water through irrigation channels.
- Proactive monitoring / maintenance / repairs of canal systems to enhance their capacity to handle increased flows.
- Undertake prompt repairs of any breaches / breaks in flood protective works.
- Inform travelers / tourists / in timely manner regarding anticipated weather / flood conditions, potential hazards, precautionary measures, and recommended alternative routes to regulate their travel and ensuring safety.
- Provide necessary assistance and support to travelers / tourists affected by flood situation, including evacuations if required.

Precautionary Measures for General Public

Rainfall / Dust-storm / Heavy Winds:

- Monitor the weather alerts through print media, electronic media, & social media.
- Stay indoor unless absolutely necessary. Keep doors and windows shut and avoid sitting near windows as rain is often accompanied by strong winds.
- Maintain a distance from power lines or electrical wires. If you notice any loose electric wires in your area, alert the authorities immediately.
- Avoid touching electrical switches or outlets while it is raining. Do not try using electrical sockets or outlets outdoors while it is raining.
- Avoid driving in heavy rain because of poor visibility.
- Avoid underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects.
- Check on family members who are especially at risk from weather hazards: young children, older adults, and the chronically ill.
- Avoid parking near walls, Weak structure, & under trees.

Hot Weather:

- Drink plenty of water and fluids.
- Avoid direct exposure to sunlight, especially between 11 AM and 3 PM.
- Ensure not to place gas cylinders in the sun.
- Be vigilant in using electricity especially during peak heat times, only use air conditioners in occupied areas of the house.
- Spend time under the shade and refrain from hard labor.
- If outside, cover your head: Use a cloth, hat or umbrella. Use sun glasses to protect your eyes.
- Help others like your neighbors, relatives and friends who cannot look after themselves (e.g. unable to move themselves).
- People suffering from heart and respiratory ailments shall stay in cool atmosphere and in case of heat strokes symptoms, shall immediately consult a doctor.
- Cars should be cleared of gas materials, lighters, carbonated beverages, perfumes and device batteries in general.
- Car windows should be slightly opened (ventilation).
- Do not fill the car's fuel tank completely and refuel the car in the early morning/late evening hours.
- Do not overinflate car tires, especially during travel.
