#### Subject RAIN WITH WIND/THUNDERSTORM PREDICTED FROM 10TH TO 15TH APRIL.

National Disaster Management Authority and Pakistan Meteorological Department have informed that rainwind/thunderstorm is expected in Sukkur, Jacobabad, Kashmore, Larkana, Dadu, Qambar Shahdad Kot, Jamshoro, Sanghar, Shaheed Benaziabad, Naushero Feroze, Shikarpur and Khairpur on **13th & 14th** April. However, isolated rainwind/thunderstorm is also expected in Karachi, Hyderabad during the period.

#### **Possible Impacts**

- Wind/thunderstorm and lightning may damage standing crops, loose structures like electric poles, vehicles and solar panels etc during the period.
- Farmers especially in wheat harvested areas are advised to manage their crops according to weather conditions.
- Tourists are advised to avoid unnecessary traveling during the wet period.
- Temperatures are likely to drop during the wet spell.

In view of the above, the Deputy Commissioner(s)/ Chairman DDMA(s), Line Departments and other relevant Authorities/ Stakeholders are requested to take necessary precautionary measures including:

- Ensure availability of dewatering machines and the staff during rainfall.
- Improve coordination with emergency services, also with various line departments.
- Establishment of helpline Cell number to address needs of affected people at priority basis.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.
- Ensure removal of vulnerable Billboards, Falling Trees, Loose Electric wires, Electric poles etc.
- Ensure coordination with Rescue 1122 Authorities.


### For General Public

- Monitor the weather alerts through print media, electronic media, & social media.
- Stay indoor unless absolutely necessary. Keep doors and windows shut and avoid sitting near windows as rain is often accompanied by strong winds.
- Maintain a distance from power lines or electrical wires. If you notice any loose electric wires in your area, alert the authorities immediately.
- Avoid touching electrical switches or outlets while it is raining. Do not try using electrical sockets or outlets outdoors while it is raining.
- Avoid driving in heavy rain because of poor visibility.
- Avoid underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects.
- Check on family members who are especially at risk from weather hazards: young children, older adults, and the chronically ill.
- Avoid parking near walls, Weak structure, & under trees.








Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) (*Press Release at Annex-A*) has forecasted that a **westerly wave** is entering Pakistan from **10**<sup>th</sup> **April** and is likely to grip most parts of the country until **15**<sup>th</sup> **April**. Under the influence, **Rain / Windstorms / Thunderstorms along with Isolated Heavy Falls and Hailstorms with Occasional Gaps** are expected in following areas of



2. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts: -

# a. KP, GB, Galiyat, Murree and State of AJ&K

- (1) **Rainfall / Thunderstorms** may **disrupt roads** during the forecasted period.
- (2) **Tourists** are advised to **remain cautious** during the spell and check weather updates before traveling.
- (3) **Electricity** / other **utility services** may **get disrupted**.
- (4) **Heavy Rainfall** may generate **flash flooding** in local nullahs / streams and river tributaries.
- (5) Landslides, mudslides, may lead to potential road blockages in Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Galiyat, Murree, Gilgit Baltistan and State of AJ&K.
- (6) Windstorms / Hailstorms may damage crops, loose structures, etc.
- (7) **Farmers** are advised to remain **extra cautious** and plan agricultural activity accordingly during the spell.
- (8) **Temperatures** are likely to **drop** during the spell.

# b. Balochistan

- (1) **Heavy rainfall** may cause **flash flooding** in local nullahs.
- (2) Hill torrents are expected in Sulaiman and the Kirthar Range.
- (3) Landslides / mudslides may lead to potential road blockages due to isolated rain spells.
- (4) Windstorms / Hailstorms may damage crops, loose structures, etc.
- (5) Electricity / other utility services may get disrupted.
- (6) **Farmers** are advised to remain **extra cautious** and plan agricultural activity accordingly during the spell.
- (7) **Temperatures** are likely to **drop** during the spell.

# c. Punjab / Sindh / Islamabad Capital Territory

- (1) Hill torrents are expected in DG Khan and Rajanpur.
- (2) **Heavy Rainfall** may generate **flash flooding** in local nullahs / streams and river tributaries.
- (3) Windstorms / Hailstorms may damage crops, loose structures, etc.
- (4) Electricity / other utility services may get disrupted.
- (5) **Farmers** are advised to remain **extra cautious** and plan agricultural activity accordingly during the spell.
- (6) Tourists are advised to remain cautious during the spell and check weather updates before traveling.
- (7) **Temperatures** are likely to **drop** during the spell.

3. All PDMAs / GBDMA / SDMA and ICT Administration, NHA, NH&MP, FWO, Rescue 1122, Dam Authorities, Line Departments, Ministries and Federal Agencies are required to undertake measures as per respective mandates. However, the following is to be ensured by all concerned, in addition to measures deemed appropriate as per on ground situation / requirements: -

- a. Ensure **round-the-clock monitoring** of the situation through EOCs with **regular feedback** to PEOCs and NEOC.
- b. DDMA/ District Administration are advised to relocate families to safe sites and shelters from mud houses in order to prevent casualties.
- c. **Forewarn travelers** / **visitors** about risks posed from flooding / landslides and likely snowfall over mountains in vulnerable locations and **provide guidance and assistance** in case of emergencies through local administration, police and rescue services.
- Ensure that in places where there is a high risk of urban floods, flash flooding, hill torrents and landslides emergency services, personnel and equipment (such as Rescue 1122, Fire Brigade, Ambulance and Civil Defense, among others) are available.
- e. **Preplace necessary emergency equipment** at vulnerable / strategic locations to expedite response efforts and **complete stocking** / replenishment of stocks.
- f. NH&MP and Traffic Police to **coordinate** with **Law Enforcement Agencies** to **manage** and **redirect traffic** from affected areas to safer areas, to prevent congestion and facilitate emergency response efforts.
- g. NHA / Line Departments to conduct **regular inspections of critical infrastructure**, such as bridges and roads, to **identify and address any vulnerability** that may leadto structural damage during heavy rainfall.
- h. PMD / FFD / PDMAs / PIDs to **proactively monitor nullahs** / **storm water drains**, to ensure their proper functioning and prevent blockages that may lead to inundation.
- Ensure widespread circulation of alerts and advisories, especially in local languages, to raise awareness and sensitize travelers / tourists and local communities in at-risk / vulnerable areas.
- j. Coordinate with relevant departments to secure loose structures such as electrical poles, solar panels, hoardings and under-construction buildings to mitigate potential damages from dust-wind / thunderstorms.
- k. Conduct mass public awareness campaigns to educate residents and travelers in vulnerable areas about the risks of flash flooding / landslides / avalanche / blizzard and take precautionary measures.

- I. Advise general public to seek shelter in safe areas, such as sturdy buildings or underground structures during dust-wind / hail-thunderstorms and avoid objects that pose a risk of falling / being struck by lightning.
- m. **Strengthen coordination** among all **relevant departments** and agencies to facilitate timely **sharing of information** and resources during emergency situations.
- n. **Establish reliable communication channels** with local communities to provide timely updates, instructions and emergency contact information.
- Advise farmers to take necessary mitigative and precautionary measures to safeguard their crops through timely harvesting, safe storage or any other precaution from adverse effects of dust-wind-thunderstorms / hailstorms and likely drop in temperatures.
- p. Share daily / routine updates with NDMA in case of any eventuality.

## Rain with Wind/Thunderstorm predicted from 10th to 15th April (with occasional gaps)

Met Office informed that a westerly wave is likely to enter upper parts of the country from 10<sup>th</sup> April followed by another strong westerly wave on 12<sup>th</sup> April that may grip most parts of the country on 13<sup>th</sup> April and persist till 15<sup>st</sup> April. Under the influence of this weather system:

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa: Rain-windstorm/thunderstorm is expected in Chitral, Dir, Swat, Abbottabad, Mansehra, Haripur, Kohistan, Shangla, Buner and Malakand from <u>10<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> April</u> with occasional gaps while, Waziristan, Kohat, Lakki Marwat, Bannu, Dera Ismail Khan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Karak, Khyber, Peshawar, Charsadda, Nowshera, Swabi, Mardan and Kurram with occasional gaps from <u>12<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> April</u>. Isolated heavy fall and hailstorm is also expected from 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> April.

<u>Gilgit-Baltistan/Kashmir</u>: Rain-wind/thunderstorm (snowfall over high mountains) is expected in Gilgit-Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar), Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) with occasional gaps from <u>10<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> April</u>. Isolated heavy fall and hailstorm is also expected from 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> April.

Punjab/Islamabad: Rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected in Murree, Galliyat, Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal on 10<sup>th</sup> and then 12<sup>th</sup> (evening/night) to 15<sup>th</sup> April, with occasional gaps while Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Faisalabad, Toba Tek Singh, Jhang, Khushab, Sargodha, Mianwali, Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Bhakkar, Layyah, Multan, Pakpattan, Sahiwal, Kot Addu, Muzaffargarh, Rahim Yar Khan, Sadiqabad, Khanpur, Bahawalnagar with occasional gaps from 12<sup>th</sup> (evening/night) to 15<sup>th</sup> April. Isolated windstorm/hailstorm is also expected from 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> April.

Balochistan: Rain-wind/thunderstorm (with isolated heavy falls) is expected in Zhob, Sherani, Barkhan, Musakhel, Kohlu, Sibbi, Jhal Magsi, Loralai, Ziarat, Quetta, Chaman, Pishin, Qila Abdullah, Qila Saifullah, Kalat, Lasbella, Khuzdar, Chagi, Panjgur, Gawadar and Kech from <u>12<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> April</u>.

Sindh: Rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected in Sukkur, Jacobabad, Kashmore, Larkana, Dadu, Qambar Shahdad Kot, Jamshoro and Sanghar on 13th & 14th April. However, isolated rain-wind/thunderstorm is also expected in Karachi, Hyderabad during the period.

#### Possible Impacts and advises:

- Heavy rainfall may generate flash flooding in local nullahs/Streams of Dir, Swat, Chitral, Kohistan, Manshera, Tributaries
  of Kabul River, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir from 13th to 15th April
- Possibility of landslides in Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Murree, Galiyat, Kashmir and Gilgit Baltistan and may affect the vulnerable locations from 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> April.
- Windstorm/hailstorm and lightning may damage standing crops, loose structures like electric poles, vehicles and solar
  panels etc during the period.
- Farmers especially in wheat harvested areas are advised to manage their crops according to weather conditions.
- Tourists are advised to avoid unnecessary traveling during the wet period.
- · Temperatures are likely to drop during the wet spell.
