**Subject      RAIN-WIND/THUNDERShower WITH ISOLATED HEAVyFALL IS EXPECTED IN  
VARIOUS PARTS OF THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that rain-wind/thundershower with isolated heavyfall is expected in Mithi, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Tando Allahyar, Badin, Thatta, Karachi, Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Shaheed Benazirabad, Naushahro Feroze, Khairpur, Dadu, Sukkur, Jacobabad, Kashmore, and Larkano districts from 26<sup>th</sup> June to 1<sup>st</sup> July with occasional gaps.

**Possible Impacts**

- Duststorm/windstorm and lightning may affect daily routines, standing crops, loose structures like electric poles, vehicles and solar panels etc. during the period.

In view of the above, the Deputy Commissioner(s)/ Chairmen DDMA(s), Line Departments and other relevant Authorities/ Stakeholders are requested to take necessary precautionary measures including SOPs of Heat wave as communicated earlier by PDMA Sindh along with following measures:

- Ensure availability of dewatering machines and the staff during rainfall.
- Improve coordination with emergency services, also with various line departments.
- Establishment of helpline Cell number to address needs of affected people at priority basis.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.
- Ensure removal of vulnerable Billboards, Falling Trees, Loose Electric wires, Electric poles etc.
- Ensure coordination with Rescue 1122 Authorities.

### **Rains predicted in the Country from 26<sup>th</sup> June to 01<sup>st</sup> July, 2024**

Met office informed that monsoon currents from Arabian sea and Bay of Bengal are likely to penetrate eastern parts of the country from 26<sup>th</sup> June and a low pressure also lies over south of Indian Gujrat. Under the influence of this weather system:

**Sindh:** Rain wind/thundershower with isolated heavyfall is expected in Mithi, Umardot, Mirpur Khas, Sanghar, Tando Allahyar, Badin, Thatta, Karachi, Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Shaheed Benazirabad, Nausheroferoze, Khairpur, Dadu, Sukkur, Jacobabad, Kashmore and Larkana from 26<sup>th</sup> June to 01<sup>st</sup> July with occasional gaps.

**Punjab/Islamabad:** Rain wind/thundershower with isolated heavyfall/hailstorm is expected in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Faisalabad, Okara, Kasur, Khushab, Sargodha, Bhakkar and Mianwali from 27<sup>th</sup> June to 01<sup>st</sup> July with occasional gaps.

**Rain/thundershower** is expected in Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Rajanpur, Rahimyar Khan and Layyah from 26<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> June.

**Gilgit-Baltistan/Kashmir:** Rain wind/thunderstorm is expected in Gilgit-Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar), Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from 28<sup>th</sup> June to 01<sup>st</sup> July with occasional gaps. Few heavy falls are also likely in Kashmir during the period.

**Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa:** Rain wind/thundershower with isolated heavyfall expected in Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Bajaur, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Hangu and Kurram from 28<sup>th</sup> June to 01<sup>st</sup> July with occasional gaps.

**Balochistan:** Rain wind/thundershower is expected in Lasbella, Khuzdar, Awaran, Jhal Magsi, Kalat, Naseerabad, Jaffarabad, Dera Bugti, Kohlu, Zhob and Barkhan from 26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> June.

#### **Possible Impacts and advises:**

- Heavy rains may cause urban/flash flood in Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Lahore, Sialkot, Gujranwala, Narowal hilly areas of Kashmir from 28<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> June.
- Duststorm/windstorm and lightning may affect daily routines, loose structures like electric poles, vehicles and solar panels etc during the period.

**Note:** All concerned authorities are advised to remain “ALERT” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation.

**گلگت بلتستان / اشیم: 28 جون سے 01 جولائی کے دوران:** گلگت بلتستان (دیامر، استور، غذر، اسکردو، ہنزہ، گلگت، گاچھے، ٹکر)، کشیر (وادی نیلم، مظفر آباد، راولکوٹ، پونچھ، ہیاں، باغ، جوہلی، سدھونی، کوٹلی، بھمبر، میرپور) میں تیز ہواں اور گرج چک کے ساتھ و قفقے سے بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران کشیر کے بعض مقامات پر موسلاحدار بارش کی بھی توقع۔

**خیبر پختونخوا: 28 جون سے 01 جولائی کے دوران:** دیر، پتھر، سوات، کوہستان، مالکانہ، بانجوڑ، شانکھ، بانگرام، بونیئر، کوہاٹ، بانجوڑ، ہمند، خیبر، مانسہرہ، ایبٹ آباد، ہری پور، پشاور، مردان، ہنگو اور کرم میں تیز ہواں اور گرج چک کے ساتھ و قفقے سے بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر موسلاحدار بارش کی بھی توقع۔

**بلوچستان: 26 جون سے 28 جون کے دوران:** لبیلہ، خضدار، آواران، جھل گسی، قلات، نصیر آباد، جعفر آباد، ذیرہ گٹھی، کولو، ٹوب اور بارکھان میں تیز ہواں اور گرج چک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔

### ملکہ اثرات اور احتیاطی ہدایت:

- 28 سے 30 جون کو موسلاحدار بارش کے باعث اسلام آباد، راولپنڈی، لاہور، سیالکوٹ، گجرانوالہ اور نردر وال میں اربن قلڈنگ کا خدش۔
- آندھی / بھجڑ چپے اور گرج چک کے باعث روزہ کے معمولات متاثر ہونے، کمزور انفراسٹرکچر (مکل کے کھبے، گاڑیوں سوار ٹینل اور غیرہ) کو نقصان کا اندر۔
