**Subject** **RAIN-WIND/THUNDERSHOWER WITH ISOLATED HEAVYFALL IS EXPECTED IN  
VARIOUS PARTS OF THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that rain-wind/thundershower with isolated heavyfall is expected in Mithi, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Tando Allahyar, Badin, Thatta, Karachi, Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Shaheed Benazirabad, Naushahro Feroze, Khairpur, Dadu, Sukkur, Jacobabad, Kashmore, and Larkano districts from **26<sup>th</sup> June to 1<sup>st</sup> July** with occasional gaps.

**Possible Impacts**

- Duststorm/windstorm and lightning may affect daily routines, standing crops, loose structures like electric poles, vehicles and solar panels etc. during the period.

In view of the above, the Deputy Commissioner(s)/ Chairmen DDMA(s), Line Departments and other relevant Authorities/ Stakeholders are requested to take necessary precautionary measures including SOPs of Heat wave as communicated earlier by PDMA Sindh along with following measures:

- Ensure availability of dewatering machines and the staff during rainfall.
- Improve coordination with emergency services, also with various line departments.
- Establishment of helpline Cell number to address needs of affected people at priority basis.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.
- Ensure removal of vulnerable Billboards, Falling Trees, Loose Electric wires, Electric poles etc.
- Ensure coordination with Rescue 1122 Authorities.

### **Rains predicted in the Country from 26<sup>th</sup> June to 01<sup>st</sup> July, 2024**

Met office informed that monsoon currents from Arabian sea and Bay of Bengal are likely to penetrate eastern parts of the country from 26<sup>th</sup> June and a low pressure also lies over south of Indian Gujrat. Under the influence of this weather system:

**Sindh:** Rain wind/thundershower with isolated heavyfall is expected in Mithi, Umarkot, Mirpur Khas, Sanghar, Tando Allahyar, Badin, Thatta, Karachi, Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Shaheed Benazirabad, Nausheroferoze, Khairpur, Dadu, Sukkur, Jacobabad, Kashmore and Larkana from **26<sup>th</sup> June to 01<sup>st</sup> July** with occasional gaps.

**Punjab/Islamabad:** Rain wind/thundershower with isolated heavyfall/hailstorm is expected in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Lahore, Sheikhpura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Faisalabad, Okara, Kasur, Khushab, Sargodha, Bhakkar and Mianwali from **27<sup>th</sup> June to 01<sup>st</sup> July** with occasional gaps. Rain/thundershower is expected in Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Rajanpur, Rahimyar Khan and Layyah from **26<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> June**.

**Gilgit-Baltistan/Kashmir:** Rain wind/thunderstorm is expected in Gilgit-Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar), Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from **28<sup>th</sup> June to 01<sup>st</sup> July** with occasional gaps. Few heavy falls are also likely in Kashmir during the period.

**Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa:** Rain wind/thundershower with isolated heavyfall expected in Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Bajaur, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Hangu and Kurram from **28<sup>th</sup> June to 01<sup>st</sup> July** with occasional gaps.

**Balochistan:** Rain wind/thundershower is expected in Lasbella, Khuzdar, Awaran, Jhal Magsi, Kalat, Naseerabad, Jaffarabad, Dera Bugti, Kohlu, Zhob and Barkhan from **26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> June**.

#### **Possible Impacts and advises:**

- Heavy rains may cause urban/flash flood in Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Lahore, Sialkot, Gujranwala, Narowal hilly areas of Kashmir from 28<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> June.
- Duststorm/windstorm and lightning may affect daily routines, loose structures like electric poles, vehicles and solar panels etc during the period.

**گلگت بلتستان/ کشمیر: 28 جون سے 01 جولائی کے دوران:** گلگت بلتستان (دیامیر، استور، غدر، اسکردو، ہنزہ، گلگت، گانچھے، شگر، کشمیر (وادئ نیلم، مظفر آباد، راولا کوٹ، پونچھ، ہٹیاں، باغ، حویلی، سدھوتی، کوٹلی، بھمبر، میرپور) میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران کشمیر کے بعض مقامات پر موسلا دھار بارش کی بھی توقع۔

**خیبر پختونخوا: 28 جون سے 01 جولائی کے دوران:** دیر، چترال، سوات، کوہستان، مالاکنڈ، باجوڑ، شانگلہ، بگٹام، پونیر، کوہاٹ، باجوڑ، مہمند، خیبر، مانسہرہ، ایبٹ آباد، ہری پور، پشاور، مردان، بنگلو اور کرم میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر موسلا دھار بارش کی بھی توقع۔

**بلوچستان: 26 جون سے 28 جون کے دوران:** لسبیلہ، خضدار، آواران، جھل، گسی، قلات، نصیر آباد، جعفر آباد، ڈیرہ گئی، کولہو، ژوب اور بارکھان میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔

**مکملہ اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:**

- 28 سے 30 جون کو موسلا دھار بارش کے باعث اسلام آباد، راولپنڈی، لاہور، سیالکوٹ، گجرانوالہ اور نارووال میں اربن فلڈنگ کا خدشہ۔
  - آندھی/جھکڑ چلنے اور گرج چمک کے باعث روزمرہ کے معمولات متاثر ہونے، کمزور انفراسٹرکچر (بجلی کے کھبے، گاڑیوں سولر پینل وغیرہ) کو نقصان کا اندیشہ۔
- نوٹ: تمام متعلقہ اداروں کو ”الٹ“ کرنے اور کسی ناخوشگوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی ہدایت کی جاتی ہے۔
