**Subject** **VERY HOT WEATHER IS LIKELY TO CONTINUE IN THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that very hot weather is likely to continue in the province for next three days, with Day time Maximum Temperatures ranges **37-39 °C** in Karachi during next 2-3 days, **47-49 °C** in Jacobabad, Dadu, Larkano, Shikarpur, Qambar Shahdadkot and Kashmore districts, **45-47 °C** in Ghotki, Sukkur, Khairpur, Naushahro Feroze, Sanghar & Shaheed Benazirabad districts while **42-44 °C** in Hyderabad, Matiari, Tando Allayar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Thatta, Sujawal and Badin districts.

Dust-thunderstorm/light rain likely to occur in Jamshoro, Thatta, Badin, Umerkot, Sanghar, Mirpurkhas & Tharparkar districts today & tomorrow.

Dust-thunderstorm/rain likely in Jamshoro, Thatta, Sujawal, Badin, Umerkot, Sanghar, Mirpurkhas, Tharparkar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Kashmore, Sukkur, Ghotki, Khairpur, Larkano, Dadu districts & outskirts of Karachi division on 28<sup>th</sup> June.

In view of the above, the Deputy Commissioner(s)/ Chairmen DDMA(s), Line Departments and other relevant Authorities/ Stakeholders are requested to take necessary precautionary measures including SOPs of Heat wave as communicated earlier by PDMA Sindh along with following measures:

- Ensure availability of dewatering machines and the staff during rainfall.
- Improve coordination with emergency services, also with various line departments.
- Establishment of helpline Cell number to address needs of affected people at priority basis.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.
- Ensure removal of vulnerable Billboards, Falling Trees, Loose Electric wires, Electric poles etc.
- Ensure coordination with Rescue 1122 Authorities.
