WEATHER OUTLOOK

Subject RAIN-SNOWFALL OVER THE HILLS PREDICTED IN UPPER PARTS OF THE COUNTRY

Met Office informed that after a long dry spell, a westerly wave has entered in Northwestern parts of Balochistan and likely to grip upper and central parts of the country on 28th (night) and may persist till 29th December.

Under The Influence of This Weather

- Light rain is expected in **Sukkur, Larkana and Jacobabad.**

Possible Impacts

- **Rain will be beneficial for the standing crops specially in Barani areas.**
- **Foggy conditions are likely to subside during the forecast period.**

Keeping in view above, it is recommended that concerned Deputy Commissioners/ Chairmen DDMA's and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures including:

- Establishment of helpline number to address needs of rain/flood affected people/IDPs at priority basis.
- Ensure provision of water and necessary emergency medicines to the general public/IDPs during Emergency.
- Stockpile necessary emergency relief/ medicine stores especially in flood affected areas.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Emergency Services / Fire Brigades to remain alert for possible fire incidents and ensure preventive measures against fires due to electrification, where possible.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.

FOR GENERAL PUBLIC/IDPs:

- Monitor the weather alerts through print and electronic media.
- Install a smoke detector and carbon monoxide detector in residential/commercial buildings/homes and make sure that their batteries are working.
- Dress warmly and limit exposure to the cold to prevent frostbite and avoid getting wet to prevent hypothermia.
- Keep emergency medicines/kits and enough snacks / food especially dry food items in stock.
- Check on family members who are especially at risk from cold weather hazards: young children, older adults, and the chronically ill.
- Travelers and tourists undertaking urgent / unavoidable travel on roads during foggy conditions, to ensure safe minimum distance between vehicles at reduced speed (as per directions NH&MP / LEAs). Avoid driving during foggy condition due to poor visibility.
