**SUBJECT: WEATHER WARNING**

Pakistan Metrological Department has informed that prevailing intense heatwave over Sindh will continue today with maximum temperature 47-49 oC in Dadu, Shaheed Benazerabad, Jacobabad, Larkana, Sukkur districts, While, Badin, Tharparkar, Umerkot & Hyderabad districts may experience maximum temperature 43-45oC and subside tomorrow. People are advised to take care during peak heatwave hours.

WEATHER FORECAST:-

Hot and dry in Central & upper Sindh with chances of Duststorm /Thunderstorm - Rain in Sukkur, Larkana, Dadu, Jacobabad, Shikarpur Kambar-Shahdkot & Jamshoro districts during 2-5 May.

Dust storm may also occur in Karachi, Hyderabad, Shaheed Benazeer Abad (Nawabshah), Thatta, Badin, Mirpurkhas & Umerkot Districts TODAY.

PRECAUTIONS MEASURES:

For DDMA's:

- DDMA's must take steps to prevent infrastructural damage, if trees, electricity wires, or billboards are blown down by strong / winds.
- DDMA's must advise owners of under-construction structures / week structured buildings to take precautions to ensure that no debris or buildings fall on people during the predicted wind storm.
- DDMA's must establish emergency response camps in the vulnerable areas.

For General Public:


- Avoid outdoor activity. If necessary to go outside, spend as little time outside as possible.
- Avoid parking their vehicles near to weak structures.
- Cover nose and mouth with surgical face mask (3 ply) or damp cloth to reduce exposure to dust particles, readily available from medical/general stores.
- Avoid vigorous exercise, especially if have bronchial asthma (dama), diabetes or a breathing-related condition.
- Stay indoors, with windows and doors closed.
- Stay in air-conditioned premises, if possible.
- If someone is an asthmatic or have a respiratory condition and develop symptoms such as shortness of breath, coughing, wheezing, or
