WEATHER WARNING

Subject **INTERMITTENT MODERATE/ HEAVY RAIN-THUNDERSTORMS EXPECTED**
IN SINDH PROVINCE

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed vide its press release dated 06th July, 2022, that, monsoon currents from the Arabian Sea are continuously penetrating into Sindh, due to which, intermittent moderate rain-thunderstorms (isolated heavy falls at times) expected in **Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Thatta, Hyderabad, Tando Allayar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Jamshoro, Sanghar, Nawabshah, Dadu, Noshero Feroz, Qambar Shaddadkot, Larkana, Shikarpur, Jacobabad, Sukkur Districts and Karachi Division** till **8th July**.

POSSIBLE IMPACTS:

- These rains may cause water logging in low lying areas in **Karachi Division, Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Dadu, Qambar Shaddadkot, Shikarpur, Larkana, Jacobabad and Sukkur Districts**.
- Water Stress is likely to ease.
- Windstorm may damage the loose & vulnerable structures including sign boards, trees etc
- Sea conditions may become Rough/Very Rough. Fishermen are advised to take extra care during the period.

Keeping in view above, it is recommended that concerned Deputy Commissioners/ Chairmen DDMA's and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures including:

- Ensure availability of dewatering machines and the staff during rainfall.
- Improve coordination with emergency services, also with various line departments.
- Establishment of helpline Cell number to address needs of affected people at priority basis.
- Ensure provision of water and necessary emergency medicines to the general public during emergency.
- Stockpile necessary emergency relief/ medicine stores especially in affected areas.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Emergency Services / Fire Brigades to remain alert for possible fire incidents and ensure preventive measures against fires due to electrification, where possible.



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- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.

FOR GENERAL PUBLIC

- Wear protective clothing and seek indoor shelter.
- Stay away from windows and doors during heavy rain and strong winds.
- Avoid roadway underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects there can be unexpectedly flood or overflow.
- Avoid driving in heavy rain due to poor visibility.
- Travelers and tourists are advised to remain extra cautious during the forecast period.
