INVITATION REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (CONSULTING SERVICES)

BASELINE / FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR SEISMIC, TSUNAMI AND CYCLONE HAZARDS ALONG COAST OF SINDH AND IDENTIFICATION OF SUITABLE SITES FOR INSTALLATION OF MULTI-HAZARD EARLY WARNING SYSTEM

The Rehabilitation Department through Provincial Disaster Management Authority. (PDMA) Government of Sindh, is mandated to execute Tsunami Early Warning System works in the public interest. The Department intends to take several protective measures to protect vulnerable public places and infrastructure from disasters like Tsunami, Earthquake and Cyclone Early Warning System for the said purpose, the Government of Sindh aims to hire the services of consultancy firms to conduct survey/ baseline study for site identification at coastal belt of Karachi Division, Badin Thatta and Sujawal Districts for installation of Tsunami Early Warning System (TEWS).

The main objectives of this assignment shall be to conduct Baseline / Feasibility Study for Seismic, Tsunami Cyclone Hazards and associated Risk Assessment along the Coast of Sindh (Karachi Division, Badin Thatta & Sujawal Districts) and Identification of Suitable Sites for Installation of Equipment for Tsunami Early Warning System, with additional capabilities for Seismic monitoring Cyclone storm surge, track, intensity prediction System.

The Rehabilitation Department through Provincial Disaster Management Authority, Government of Sindh now hereby invites eligible Consultancy Firm which are duly registered with the Government Income Tax and Sales Tax Departments, Survey of Pakistan (SOP), and other relevant statutory authorities, and to indicate their interest for providing the required services. Proofs of said registrations are required to be provided/ established in EOI Responses/Applications.

The eligible consulting firms are required to demonstrate/provide following requisite information to prove their qualification/eligibility to perform the assignment. Consultancy firms are encouraged to provide materials/ information that would be specific to the proposed services only by giving all the relevant details as required in the marking schedule below, and to avoid submitting generic promotional material. The unrelated or incomplete materials/information shall not be considered. The Terms of References (TORs) can be downloaded from this authority's website www.pdma.gos.pk. The parameters for evaluating the EOI responses, are given against each requisite as under whereas minimum of 70% marks shall be required for qualification of the Firm(s) for issuance of Request of Proposal Document for inviting Technical & Financial Proposals:

 a) Complete historical profile of the organization/firm with the information i.e. incorporation certificate, experience, corporate profile indicating years of operations, core competencies, management structure & systems etc. Information related to the provincial / regional / field offices, permanent/intermittent staff, panel of experts etc. shall be a prerequisite. [Max. Score = 20]

- b) Details of completed projects of similar nature, size and scale at national, provincial or regional level with requisite information i.e. project description, cost of the project, client, duration, number of field staff hired/mobilized & managed, type & scale of field mobilization, and type of association / JV if any. [Max. Score = 40]
- Geographical experience / presence of the firm of the firm at national, provincial or regional level. [Max. Score = 15]
- Demonstrated capacity / experience of conducting similar evaluations / assessments/field surveys/research, etc. [Max. Score = 15]
- e) The Average Annual Turnover of the Consultant should not be less than 25 Million.

 [Max. Score = 10]

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The Consultancy Firm will be selected through "Quality & Cost Based Selection (QCBS) Method" in accordance with the procedures set out in the Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010, issued by the Sindh Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (SPPRA), (as amended from time to time) which can be perused at the website: www.pdma.gos.pk

Expressions of Interest response (in person or by mail), must be delivered in a written form, in sealed envelope, to the address below by or before 1430 hours on 30th April, 2021, which shall be opened on same day in the office of Director (Ops) / Chairman Consultant Selection Committee at 1530 hours in the presence of representatives of participating Consultancy Firms who may choose to be present. The response submitted after due time will be not be entertained.
